

## James Boyer Ellis (1866 – 1921)

James Boyer Ellis was born May 11<sup>th</sup> 1866 to James L. Ellis and Sarah Henrietta Boyer <sup>1</sup> in Pottstown Pennsylvania. He married Mary L Sauer. <sup>2</sup> Mary was born October 20<sup>th</sup> 1860 to Christopher and Appolonia Sauer in Reading Berks County Pennsylvania. Her parents were both born in Germany. <sup>3</sup>

James and Mary lived at 925 Washington Street , and 315 North 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Reading Pennsylvania. James worked for the Pennsylvania Reading Railroad.

James died March 28<sup>th</sup> 1921 while living in Reading Pennsylvania. <sup>4</sup> He was laid to rest in Section C, Plot 679, Grave #4, at the Saint Paul's R. C. Church Gethsemane Cemetery and Mausoleum in Laureldale Pennsylvania. <sup>5</sup> Mary died September 25<sup>th</sup> 1932, <sup>6</sup> and was laid to rest next to her husband in Section C, Plot 679, Grave #5. <sup>7</sup>

James and Mary had five children.

- i. James E. Ellis was born August 29<sup>th</sup> 1888 in Reading Pennsylvania. He lived at 315 North 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Reading, where he was a merchant. James never married, and he died of Pulmonary Endometriosis on September 12<sup>th</sup> 1929. <sup>8</sup> He was laid to rest September 16<sup>th</sup> 1929 in the Ellis family plot, Section C, Plot 679, Grave #3. <sup>9</sup>
- ii. Charles Elwood. Ellis was born 1890, and died April 16<sup>th</sup> 1975. He was laid to rest April 18<sup>th</sup> 1975. Section C, Plot 679, Grave #6, at the Saint Paul's R. C. Church Gethsemane Cemetery and Mausoleum in Laureldale Pennsylvania. <sup>10</sup>
- iii. Paul J. Ells was born November 4<sup>th</sup> 1891 in Reading Berks County Pennsylvania. <sup>11</sup> He married Berta, and they lived in Reading Pennsylvania where he worked for a cable worker for the local telephone company. Paul died February 10<sup>th</sup> 1952 and was laid to rest February 11<sup>th</sup> 1952 in the Ellis family plot; Section C, Plot 679, Grave #1. <sup>12</sup>
- iv. Mary A. Ellis was born February 11<sup>th</sup> 1893 in Reading Berks County Pennsylvania. She was a registered nurse, and never married. She was almost 22 years old when she died from phenomena related to Pulmonary Edema on January 27<sup>th</sup> 1921. <sup>13</sup> She was laid to rest January 31<sup>st</sup> 1921 in the Ellis family plot, Section C, Plot 679, Grave #2. <sup>14</sup>
- v. Anna S. Ellis was born January 1895. She lived with her parents at 315 North 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Reading Pennsylvania. In 1920 she was a 25 year old school teacher. By 1922 she was still living with her mother at their home on 10<sup>th</sup> street. <sup>15</sup>
