

Charles Edwin Klinger Jr. (1874 – 1927)

Charles Edwin Klinger Jr. was born on April 8th 1874¹ to Charles Klinger Sr. and Melinda Daniels in Lykens, Wiconisco Township in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Charles was of medium height and build, with blue eyes and brown hair. On January 5th 1899, at age 24, Charles married 24 year old Emma Long² Kinter.³ The marriage was conducted by Alexander Lamberson in Harrisburg Pennsylvania.⁴

Emma was also known as Emmy, and she was born March 17th 1873⁵ to Andrew G. Kinter and Matilda Huss in Dillsburg York County Pennsylvania. Emma's sister was Kate M. Kinter who married Charles's younger brother Harry Victor Klinger in 1916.

Charles Edwin Klinger Jr. and Emma Long Kitner had the following children:

- i. Ethel Laura Klinger (1900 – 1972)
- ii. Edwin Charles Klinger (1903 – 1985)
- iii. Helen M. Klinger (1906 – 1927)
- iv. Alma R. Klinger (1908 – 1994)
- v. Pansey Ida Klinger (1912 – 2004)
- vi. Clarence William Klinger (1914 – 1970)

In 1900 Charles and Emma lived with his parents on Hanna Street in what is known today as Shipoke Area of South Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Some of this area is currently the front street on ramp and 2nd street off ramp interchange to Interstate 83.

By 1910 the family moved to 119 Vine Street, a few blocks north from Hanna Street, off South 2nd and South 3rd Streets. Charles Jr. and Emma were living with Emma's father Andrew Kinter who is widowed at 60 years old.

Emma's sister, Kate Kinter, is also living with the family in 1910, and in 1916 Kate marries Harry Klinger, Charles's young brother. The Kitner family is from the Dillsburg area of York County Pennsylvania. I can only assume that Emma's father, Andrew, had some sort of relationship with Charles who was in the fruits and produce business.

According to the Klinger family, Charles at about 30 years old worked on the newly built Pennsylvania Capitol Building Dome.⁶ Construction of the Capitol building began with ground breaking on November 2nd 1902, and ending with its dedication on October 4th 1906. On Charles WWI Draft registration card, he indicated he was a produce dealer working for H. R. Whitcomb, located on Chestnut Street Market House, Harrisburg.

Between 1920 and 1927 Charles and Emma lived on South Court Street, further north from Vine Street. On October 6th 1927⁷ at 9:25 P.M, at 53 years old, Charles E. Klinger Jr. died at the Polyclinic Hospital Harrisburg Pennsylvania of pulmonary tuberculosis. That same year his daughter Helen M. Klinger died at 21 years old. They are both buried together in the Paxtang Cemetery Harrisburg PA, row 14, stone #7.⁸ The circumstances seem to reflect they both died at the exact same date, maybe having the same cause of death.

After 1927, Emma, Alma, Pansey, and Clarence began living with Emma's oldest daughter, Ethel L. Stephens at 84 Luce Street Harrisburg.⁹ During Emma's later years, along with her daughter Pansey, they worked for the McCormick's at their 101 North Front Street Mansion in Harrisburg, living in the rear of the mansion as a domestic servant.

The last McCormick son to live at the mansion was Donald McCormick, who also served as president of Dauphin Deposit Bank. Upon Donald's death in 1945, the house was willed to the Harrisburg Public Library. Emma left her employment and moved in with her youngest daughter Pansey and her husband Elmer Dorer. They lived at 2314 Berry Hill Street, Allison Hill Harrisburg Pennsylvania, until about the mid 1960's when Emma moved into the Dauphin County Home. Emma was 98 years old when she died September 22nd 1971.¹⁰ At the time of her death, she was living in the Dauphin County Home in Swatara Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Emma was laid to rest September 24th 1971 in the Paxtang Cemetery Harrisburg Pennsylvania.¹¹

Ethel Laura Klinger (1900 - 1972)

Ethel Laura Klinger was born January 13th 1900¹² to Charles Klinger and Emma Kinter in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. On March 11th 1919 in Harrisburg Pennsylvania at age 19 Ethel married 19 year old Henry Calvin Heider by Reverend G. E. Hawes.¹³

Harry Calvin Heider was born August 4th 1899 in Fredrick Maryland.¹⁴ His father was Harry Heider who was born in Selinsgrove Snyder County Pennsylvania, and Lillie Catherine Hann who was born in Fredrick Maryland. In 1919 Harry Calvin Heider was a Machinist Helper for the Pennsylvania Railroad, and living in Harrisburg Pennsylvania with his parents.¹⁵

For some reason in 1920, Ethel was married living with her parents Charles and Emma Klinger, and her husband Harry, who was also married and still working for the railroad was living with his parents, Harry and Katherine Heider. Ethel filed for divorce on grounds of desertion. They were divorced in the Dauphin County Court during the January Term 1922, case number, 457-922. On February 24th 1923 Harry remarried to Katherine Sergeant in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Katherine was born about 1905 to Archibald Sergeant and Katherine Hoffman.¹⁶ Harry and Ethel Klinger did not have any children.

On April 1st 1923, 23 year old Ethel Laura Klinger-Heider remarried to 25 year old Charles Edgar Stephens while they lived in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Charles was born March 2nd 1898¹⁷ to Jesse K Stephens and Bertha M Owens in Pennsylvania.¹⁸ Charles Jr. signed his WWI draft registration on September 12th 1918, and he identified Ethel L. Stephens as the person who will always know his address. Charles Edgar Stephens and Ethel L. Klinger had the following children:

- i. Charles E. Stephens was born in April 1926 in Pennsylvania
- ii. Paul A. Stephens was born in April 1928 in Pennsylvania.
- iii. Vernon E. Stephens was born 1931 in Pennsylvania
- iv. William A. Stephens was born in 1934
- v. Robert Q. Stephens was born in 1937.

The family lived in the Boiling Springs area of South Middleton Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Ethel L. Stephens died March 24th 1972, and was laid to rest in the Westminster Memorial Gardens in Carlisle Pennsylvania.¹⁹

Edwin Charles Klinger (1903 – 1985)

Edwin (Ed) Charles Klinger was born August 12th 1903 to Charles Klinger and Emma Kinter in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He died August 12th 1985 at age of 83. His funeral service was held Friday, August 16th 1982, 1:30 P.M, at the Myers Funeral Home 37 East Main Street Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. The Reverend Kraig L. Faust conducted the service. Ed was buried August 16th 1985 at Rolling Green Cemetery Camp Hill Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ²⁰

At age 23 Ed married 21 year old Irene Mary Wrightstone ²¹ on April 29th 1926 in Annville Pennsylvanian by Reverend Walter E. Waggoner. ²²

On April 3rd 1930 Ed and Irene lived in Shiremanstown Borough Lower Allen Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. At that time Ed work as a laborer in a brickyard. I recall driving with him, and he showed me the brickyard which was in ruins, and located at the intersection of present day Elmerton Avenue and PA State Route 22, adjacent to the Pennsylvania State Veterinarian Lab. Ed also worked as a Fruit and Produce Helper/Dealer with his father, a Milkman delivering milk, and a janitor for Wilcox Forging in Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania.

During the mid to late 1930's the family lived at 519 West Main Street Mechanicsburg. They moved and lived in the 1940's to the early 1960's at 18 South Chestnut Street Mechanicsburg. Then they moved from Chestnut Street to 2 Park Road, Silver Springs Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania; about one mile from Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. They lived there the remaining years of their lives. Their son Russell lived with them until he died in 2008.

I remember Grandpa telling me stories of his younger days, and his family. He told of how he and his dad had a fruit stand at the Broad Street market located on 3rd street in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. I recall him telling me how he traveled across the river to Camp Hill and New Cumberland buying produce to sell at the market.

This may be how Ed met his wife Irene Mary Wrightstone, who at this time was living on a farm in Lemoyne Borough, Lower Allen Township Cumberland County; directly across the Susquehanna River on either the Walnut Street or Market Street Bridges. Her father was a tenet farmer, and I suspect they either sold fruit or produce to Charles and Sons green grocers of the Shipoke area of Harrisburg. After he married Grandma, he delivered milk out along the Enola Road, Route 944.

Ed and Irene Klinger had four children.

- i. Russell Edwin Klinger (1926-2007): Russell was born September 25th 1926 to Ed Klinger and Irene Wrightstone in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Russell 1st married Joyce Bemiller of Mechanicsburg PA. They lived in an apartment at 325 West Main Street Mechanicsburg PA. They divorced, and Russell then married Ruth and they lived on Silver Springs Road near his parents Ed and Irene.

Russ worked for the Department of Defense Naval Supply Command in Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. Russell had no children with either wife. He died at the age of 80 ²³ on March 17th 2007 in Mechanicsburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

Russell's social security information indicated his last residence was McAlisterville Juniata County Pennsylvania,²⁴ but he lived in his parent's home starting in the mid 1970's until his death at 81 years old on March 17th 2007.

- ii. Dorothy Irene Klinger (1928-2001): Dottie was born November 28th 1928 to Ed Klinger and Irene Wrightstone in Shiresmanstown Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Dorothy married Robert Harvey Graham on November 5th 1948 in Mechanicsburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Robert and Dorothy Graham's children are: Joan Aileen Graham, Rosemary Ann Graham, Robert Calvin Graham, and Deborah Louise Graham.

Dottie died one day short of her 73rd birthday on November 27th 2001. Her funeral was held Saturday December 1st 2001 at 11:00 A.M. in the Myers Funeral Home, 37 East Main Street Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. Reverend Thomas S. Mellott conducted the services.²⁵ Dottie was buried December 2nd 2001 next to her husband in the Dillsburg Cemetery, Dillsburg York County Pennsylvania.²⁶

- iii. Richard Charles Klinger (1930-1979): Dick was born November 29th 1930 to Ed Klinger and Irene Wrightstone in Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. He was 48 years old when he died of cancer on Tuesday March 20th 1979 at the Mercy Catholic Center in Philadelphia Pennsylvania. His funeral was held on March 23rd 1979 at the Myers Funeral Home 37 East Main Street Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. The Reverend Stewart F. Bingman conducted the services.²⁷

Dick was an Air Force veteran of the Korean War, a member of the Mechanicsburg VFW Post 6704, a member of the Mechanicsburg American Legion Post 109, and the Shepherdstown United Methodist Church. Dick worked for the Harrisburg Division of the General Medical Corporation.²⁸

Dick married Lola J. Guise in 1961 at the Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in York Springs Adams County PA. Lola was born in York Springs Adams County Pennsylvania to Emory Guise and Edith Lobaugh. Lola's siblings were: Ruth G. Guise, Mary Guise, Virginia E. Guise, Robert L. Guise, Dale Emory Guise, Glenn L. Guise, Ethel M. Guise, Ester R. Guise, and Laura A. Guise.²⁹

Dick and Lola Klinger lived at 5 Juniper Drive Mechanicsburg Pennsylvania. Dick and Lola Klinger had the following 9th American Klinger generation:

- a. Jay W. Klinger
- b. Donna J. Klinger

- iv. Betty Ethel Klinger was born December 18th 1932 to Ed Klinger and Irene Wrightstone in Cumberland County Pennsylvania. She married John Joseph Hooven II on February 28th 1953 in Hagerstown Maryland. They live at 108 Walton Street Lemoyne Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

After Betty married John, she began using the middle initial of "K", for Klinger. She told the family that she hated her middle name of Ethel, which is from her mother's sister Julia's middle name and Ed's sister's name.

John Joseph Hooven II was born on June 1st 1930 and died at the age of 61 on June 15th 1991³⁰ in Lemoyne Cumberland County Pennsylvania. John worked as a car salesman for Freysinger Pontiac in New Cumberland Pennsylvania. John and Betty Hooven's children are:

- a. John Joseph Hooven was born August 26th 1953. He married 1st to Kathleen Miller, and together they had one child; Valerie A. Hooven who was born January 18th 1984. John married 2nd to Karen Austria in 2010, and they had no children. Karen had one son from a previous marriage.
- b. Linda Jo Hooven was born June 1st 1955. Linda married John W. Cook on August 23rd 1985. They live in York Haven York County Pennsylvania. Like their cousins, they adopted children from China region of Mongolia. They are Rebecca Elizabeth Cook who was born 1997, and Sarah Ellen Cook who was born 2002.

Helen M. Klinger (1905 – 1927)

Helen M. Klinger was born August 11th 1905 to Charles Klinger and Emma Kinter in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. On her birth notice, her father Charles's occupation was listed as a Huckster. Her mother's name was written as Emmy.³¹ Helen was 14 years old when she lived with her parents on 108 South Court Street Harrisburg; 3rd ward 1st precinct. She died in 1927, the same year as her father. They are buried together in the Harrisburg Paxtang Cemetery, row 14, headstone # 7.³² I'm researching to determine any relationship between the 1927 deaths of Charles and Helen.

Alma R. Klinger (1908 – 1994)

Alma R. Klinger was born December 19th 1908 to Charles Klinger and Emma Kinter in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. She died March 23rd 1994 at the age of 85³³ while living in Lower Allen Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Alma is buried in the Paxtang Cemetery Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Alma was a member of the Steelton Women of the Moose, the East End Democratic Club, and the Women's Benefit Association.³⁴ On February 28th 1934 she lived at 349 Nectarine Street Harrisburg, Dauphin County PA.

Alma was 25 years old when she married on March 1st 1934 to Jacob Krahling, who was 23 years old. Jacob was born February 1st 1911 in Enhaut Dauphin County Pennsylvania to Henry Krahling of Jugo Slavina and Catherine Robinstine of Austria Hungary.³⁵ Jacob died May 1982 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.³⁶ Jacob and Alma Krahling had one child: Katherine Black of Harrisburg PA who was born about 1934.³⁷

Pansey Ida Klinger (1912 – 2004)

Pansey Ida Klinger was born May 30th 1912 to Charles Klinger Jr. and Emma Kinter in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

Pansey was a member of the Market Square Presbyterian Church Harrisburg Pennsylvania where she sang in the choir. She was a housekeeper for Dauphin Manor and a former employee of the Harrisburg School District.³⁸ At the time of Pansey's marriage application on October 21st 1940 she lived 1512 Berryhill Street Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

Pansey married Elmer E. Dorer on November 2nd 1940 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He was born July 23rd 1917 in Sunbury Northumberland County Pennsylvania. He died May 14th 1988,³⁹ and is buried at the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery, Section 11 Site 1069.⁴⁰ - ⁴¹ Elmer's parents were Ralph Dorer who was born in Williamsport Lycoming County Pennsylvania, and Helen Smith who birth place was not known. Both of Elmer's parents were deceased at the time of the marriage.⁴²

Elmer was living at 205 Harris Street Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania when he applied for his marriage license with Pansey. He entered the Army on November 15th 1944, and retired as a staff sergeant with more than 32 years of service, and was a World War II veteran. His brother is George H. Dorer who lived in Columbus Georgia. Elmer and Pansey Dorer had two children.

- i. Richard E. Dorer was born after 1940, and lived at 2314 Berryhill St, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.
- ii. James E. Dorer was born after 1940, and lived at 5638 Lancaster St, Apt B, Harrisburg, and in Eppers Pennsylvania.

Pansey died at the age of 91 on January 20th 2004,⁴³ while living at the Spring Creek Rehabilitation and Health Center Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Pansey is buried in the Paxtang Cemetery Harrisburg Pennsylvania.

Clarence William Klinger (1914 – 1970)

Clarence William Klinger was born December 7th 1914 to Charles Klinger and Emma Kinter in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He married Helen, who was born in 1917 in Pennsylvania.

Clarence was an engineer for the Harrisburg Steel, and a member of the Steel Workers Union, 1608. Clarence and Helen had a son.

- i. Robert Klinger was born January 22nd 1937 in Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He married and lived in Rocky Hill Connecticut, where he died July 2nd 1986.

Clarence died June 1970.⁴⁴ Clarence was laid to rest at the Woodlawn Memorial Gardens, 4855 Londonderry Road, Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.⁴⁵
