Jane E. Ellis (1840 – 1912)

Jane Elizabeth Ellis ⁱ was born July 12th 1840 to James Ellis ¹ and Mary Ann Luxon ² in St. Austell, Cornwall England. Jane was baptized September 6th 1840, while the family lived Stenalees St Austell located in Corwall England. ³

Jane married William Quick.⁴ In 1900 and 1910 she indicated she was a widow who lived in Reading, and she had no children.

Jane died May 25th 1912 in Reading Berks County Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest in the Charles Evans Cemetery, Reading Berks County Pennsylvania.⁵

ⁱ Jane's middle name Elizabeth is an assumption; based on British naming conventions of the time.
