4.6 Annie Josephine Greenawalt (*Unknown German Parent , Nichalos-1, Peter-2, Henry-3*) Annie was born February 13th 1875 in Southampton Township Franklin County Pennsylvania.

Annie married Enos Neisley (Nicley ⁱ) Wenger March 18th 1897 in Letterkenny Township Franklin County Pennsylvania. He was born July 1874 in Letterkenny Township to Joseph Zook Wenger and Annie B. Neisley. Joseph Z. was born September 1836/1838 and Annie B. was born May 1838/1842. Joseph and Annie married about 1866, and together they had ten children, but only eight were still living by 1900.

Enos was first married to Anna Hostetter who was born February 13th 1875. This is interesting, because Annie Greenawalt's sister, Sadie Greenawalt, also had an illegitimate son who was named Earl Brinton Hostetter. Earl would later adopt the Greenawalt name.

In 1900 Enos and Annie lived in Letterkenny Township Franklin County Pennsylvania where Enos worked as a day laborer. Enos and Annie would leave the Letterkenny Township area, and go to Philadelphia where Enos would work at Franklin Worsted Mill, which was owned and operated by Annie's brother David Franklin Greenawalt. Enos's World War I Draft Registration card indicated he and Annie lived at 2543 North Lawrence Philadelphia Pennsylvania, where Enos worked as a Loom Fixer for the Franklin Worsted Company. This company was located at Mascher and York Streets in Philadelphia. ⁱⁱ

Before 1920 they then moved to North Emerald Street Philadelphia Pennsylvania, while Enos continued his trade as a Loom Fixer for his brother-in-law David Greenawalt. In 1930 Enos continued to work as a Loom Fixer for his brother-in-law at the Franklin Worsted Company located at G and Venango Streets Philadelphia Pennsylvania. ⁱⁱⁱ Annie and Enos lived in South Philadelphia, her nephew Guy Angle Greenawalt lived with them while Guy worked for a civilian defense contractor. ^{iv}

Enos died January 9th 1923, and Annie died 1962. Enos could not have died in 1923 because he was listed in the 1930 census record.

According to the 1900 census record for Letterkenny Township Franklin County Pennsylvania, Enos and Annie had been married for three years. This suggests that their child, Merle was born out of wedlock. There is no formal record to suggest that Merle was formally adopted by Enos, or that Merle used Greenawalt as his formal legal name. We'll check Franklin and Cumberland County records. Other member's believe that Merle is formally known as a Greenawalt. Interestingly, Annie's older sister, Sadie, also had a son out of wedlock; Earl Brinton Greenawalt, whose father was a Hostetter. This is so interesting...we have so many late 19th century ladies having babies out of wedlock...And we thought we have trouble one hundred years later in the late 20th Century. So funny....

4.6.1. Merle Lester Wenger was born May 26th 1894 in Shippensburg Pennsylvania. He married Elizabeth May Brown who was born June 1st 1895 and died January 26th 1978. Merle died November 6th 1959 and is laid to rest at the Methodist Church Cemetery, Porchtown, New Jersey. Their children were:
