

Clarence Edward Agle (1882-1904)

Clarence Edward Agle was born September 1882 to Edward Tobias Agle and Anna Catherine Graham in Shippensburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ¹

On June 21st 1900 Clarence was listed with his parents in Shippensburg, working as a helper in iron works. But he was also listed as a day laborer in the June 1st 1900 census record, living with Pernules Gallagher and his wife Naomi, at South Second Street in the borough of Steelton, just outside of Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. At the time the town of Steelton was known for its many steel mills, and iron works.

Clarence was 21 years old when he married 20 year old Dessie Anna Haney (Hanney) ² on November 14th 1903 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Dessie was born April 20th 1883 ³ to William and Buelah Dill ¹ Haney. ⁴ Dessie's father was a farmer and lived in Aqueduct, which is located in Penn Township Perry County Pennsylvania.

Clarence would later work as a brakeman for the Pennsylvania Rail Road, when at 21 years old on July 1st 1904; he was killed near the town of Vineyard in Mifflin County Pennsylvania. ⁱⁱHis funeral services were held at his home 1908 Moetke Avenue in Harrisburg, by Rev. F.W. Biddle of the Curtin Heights Methodist Evangelical Church. Clarence was laid to rest at the Harrisburg Cemetery; locate at 521 North 13th Street, Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. FAG#143701738

Clarence Agle and Dessie Haney had one child before Clarence died July 1st 1904. ⁱⁱⁱ

Dessie then married when she was 26 years old, and pregnant, to 32 year old Oliver G. Leiter on February 25th 1909 in the McAllisteville area of Fayette Township Juniata Count Pennsylvania. Oliver was an engineer for the railroad, and was born August 16th 1877 to Samuel ^{iv} and Sarah Leiter in Juanita County Pennsylvania. ⁵

- Oliver was 21 years old when he previously married 20 year old Anna M. Reynolds on March 23rd 1899 in Mifflintown Juniata County. ⁶ Anna was born January 23rd 1879 to Lewis C. and Anna Reynolds in Juniata County.
- The family lived in McAllisterville, Fayette Township, Juniata County, when Anna died of tuberculosis of the lungs and bowels, on September 27th 1907. She was laid to rest September 30th 1907 in the Mifflintown Cemetery in Juniata County. ⁷ FAG#143743321
- Oliver and Ann had these children: Wilson I Leiter was born in 1899; Viola Leiter was born 1903, and Frank Leiter was born 1905.

ⁱⁱ One of the most valuable mineral deposits in the Juniata valley is the glass sand found in the vicinity of Lewistown, Vineyard and McVeytown in Mifflin county, near Mapleton.

ⁱⁱⁱ On Dessie marriage application with Cloyd Maxwell, she indicates the death of her 1st husband, Clarence Agle, as July 1st 1902. This is an error, since they married in 1903.

^{iv} Oliver's father's name was Samuel on his marriage applications, but it was Joseph on his death certificate. Since Oliver would have identified his father's name on the marriage applications, and not his own death certificate. We use the name Samuel as his father.

- Wilson Leiter was 20 years old when he married 16 year old Louisa Martha Carnathan on July 23rd 1919 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Lousia was born 1903 to John F. Carnathan and Annie Alman.⁸

By 1910 Dessie Leiter and her son Clarence Agle, lived with Oliver and his family at 1911 North 7th Street Harrisburg. Also living with Oliver and Dessie was Oliver's mother, Sara Schreffler (b. 1858) and Oliver's step brother, Samuel W. Schreffler (b.1895).

- Oliver died of Typhoid fever on November 10th 1913 at the Harrisburg City Hospital. He was laid to rest November 18th 1913^v in Mifflintown Juanita County Pennsylvania. Jennie Leiter was the informant on the death certificate.⁹ FAG#143701936^{vi}

Dessie was a seamstress, and on January 5th 1917 she married 43 year old Cloyd E. Maxwell in Duncannon in Penn Township Perry County Pennsylvania. Cloyd was born August 22nd 1868¹⁰ to David Maxwell and Sarah S. Kretzinger.¹¹

- Cloyd Maxwell was 22 years old when he 1st married 22 year old Mary E. Peterman on February 19th 1889 at Lash's Run in Perry County Pennsylvania.¹² Mary was born April 16th 1867 to Jacob Peterman and Lydia Smith in the Newport and Duncannon areas of Miller Township Perry County Pennsylvania.
- Mary Peterman-Maxwell was 40 years old when she died April 22nd 1907 in Penn Township Perry County Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest April 24th in the Presbyterian Cemetery Duncannon Pennsylvania.¹³ FAG#143699509^{vii}
- Cloyde and Mary had a son Curtis F. Maxwell who was born about 1891. Curtis was 19 years old when he married 17 year old Julia E. Lowe on August 24th 1910 in Duncannon Perry County Pennsylvania. Julia was born 1893 to Gorge W. and Maggie H. Lowe.¹⁴

In 1920 Cloyde and Dessie lived in Pen Township, in the Duncannon area of Perry County Pennsylvania. Dessie's three daughters' she had with Oliver Leiter lived with them. In 1930 Melvin D Leiter, a grandson, (b. 1927) lived with the family in Duncannon.

In 1940 the family moved to 216 East North Street in Carlsile Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

Cloyd died October 8th 1957, and was laid to rest the Duncannon Union Cemetery in Duncannon Perry County Pennsylvania.¹⁵ FAG#22883170^{viii}

Dessie was 89 years old when she died February 22nd 1972 in Perry County Pennsylvania.¹⁶ Dessie was laid to rest in the Duncannon Union Cemetery in Duncannon Perry County Pennsylvania.¹⁷ FAG#22883172^{ix}

Clarence Agle and Dessie Haney had one child 1903-1904.

- i. Clarence Edward Agle was born October 9th 1904¹⁸ in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

Clarence lived with his mom until he married Blanch Belton¹⁹ about 1927. Blanch was born May 19th 1909.²⁰

Beginning in 1930 his family would live at 6 Delaware Avenue in Juniata Terrance, Grantville Township Mifflin County Pennsylvania. Clarence and worked as a foreman for Viscos Silk Company in Lewistown.

Clarence was 56 years old when he died of a heart attack in Gantville Mifflin County, where he lived 2 1/2 miles out of the borough. He was laid to rest February 16th 1962 at the Duncannon Union Cemetery in Perry County Pennsylvania. Mrs Donald Weikel of Lewistown was the informant on his death certificate.²¹ FAG#22615763^x

Blanch passed away May 6th 1976, and was laid to rest with her husband at the Duncannon Union Cemetery. FAG#22615762²²

Clarence and Blanch had two children.

- a. Blanch N. Agle was born April 20th 1929. She married Osborn. Blanch died May 2nd 1960. She was laid to rest at the Duncannon Union Cemetery. FAG#25183463
- b. Joyce A. Agle was born 1930

- ii. Beulah Sara Leiter was born October 1909. She was 16 years old when she married William Edward Weaver on August 21st 1925 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. William was bornto Edwin L. Weaver and Sallie M. Koones.²³
