

Cora Annie Agle (1891-1966)

Cora A. Agle was born May 1891 to Edward Tobias Agle and Anna Catherine Graham in Shippensburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania.¹

Cora lived with her parents up until she married Lawrence McCaleb in Southampton Township Cumberland county Pennsylvania. Lawrence lived in St. Louis in 1910, where he was in show business as an entertainer.

She married Lawrence Blair McCaleb.² Lawrence was born November 22nd 1889 to George McCaleb and Elizabeth Heberling¹ in Oakville located in Newton Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania.³

In 1920 Lawrence's brother, Oren C McCaleb and his wife, Ruth M., lived with them at 139 Summit Street in East Pennsboro Township Cumberland County. Lawrence was in the retail fresh meat business.

1930 Lawrence's sister, Mary M. McCaleb, lived with them at 147 Columbia Road in East Pennsboro Township. Lawrence owns and operates his own butcher shop.

By 1940 the family moved to St Petersburg in Pinellas County, Florida 18 Avenue South, and later at 2420 Tangerine Avenue in St. Petersburg Florida

Lawrence was 68 years old when he died of a coronary occlusion in Blue Grass Avenue in Linglestown, Lower Paxtang Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest September 15th 1958 at the Memorial Park Cemetery in St. Petersburg Pinellas County Florida. His son, Jesse, was the informant on his death certificate.⁴ FAG#143780654ⁱⁱ

Cora died September 1966,⁵ and was laid to rest with her husband at the Memorial Park Cemetery.

Cora Agle and Lawrence McCaleb had one child.

- i. Jesse L. McCaleb was born June 19th 1917⁶ to Lawrence B. McCaleb and Cora Annie Agle in Enola East Pennsboro Cumberland County Pennsylvania. He lived with his parents to 1940.

Jesse was 32 years old when he married 25 year old Myra M Bollenbach on July 9th 1949 in Detroit located in Wayne County Michigan. Myra was born February 24th 1924 to Henry Bollenbach and Elizabeth Schultz⁷ in Detroit, Wayne County Michigan.

Myra worked in the office of Chrysler Motor Company, and in 1951 the family moved to Jesse's home in St. Petersburg Florida. In the area of St. Petersburg, Myra was a Leader of the Girl Scouts and President of the Women's Auxillary of the West Exchange Club. She was a member of the Science Center Guild, the Women's Service League, St. Petersburg Yacht Club and Lakewood Country Club (currently St. Petersburg Country Club) where she scored a hole in one.

Myra was a receptionist at Sunny Shores Villas (currently Westminster Shores) and the Mahaffey Company. She attended First Presbyterian Church, and was an avid golfer and bridge player. Myra's personality made an impression on everyone she met.

Jesse was 72 years old when died July 4th 1989.⁸ He was laid to rest at the Memorial Park Cemetery in St. Petersburg Pinellas County Florida.⁹ FAG#120271385

Myra was 89 years old when she passed away on Saturday, November 9th 2013 after a long illness. She was laid to rest at the Memorial Park Cemetery in St. Petersburg Pinellas County Florida. FAG# 120271016
