

## Cora A. Graham (1869-1950)

Cora A.<sup>i</sup> Graham was born December 8<sup>th</sup> 1869<sup>1</sup> to William Graham (1833-1908)<sup>2</sup> and Mary Oliver<sup>3</sup> or Mary Allewelt<sup>4</sup> in Shippensburg Pennsylvania.

Cora was 25 years old when she married 21 year old William John Wennell on June 27<sup>th</sup> 1895 at her parent's home<sup>5</sup> in Shippensburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania.<sup>6</sup>

William was born February 21<sup>st</sup> 1874<sup>7</sup> to George W. Wennell (1847-1875)<sup>8</sup> and Mary Anna Grimm in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. William was a laborer and steam fitter, and we believe in 1894-1896 he was working in Shippensburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania.<sup>ii</sup>

In 1898 William lived at 106 Cowden Street in Harrisburg, and by 1900 Cora and William lived in the 3<sup>rd</sup> precinct at 31 Balm Street in Harrisburg, where William worked as a steam fitter at a local pipe works. While living in this area, Cora attended the Methodist Episcopal Church, where she gave an offering of \$.50.<sup>9</sup> By 1910 Cora and William was still living in the 3<sup>rd</sup> precinct, but lived at 26 Bailey Street Harrisburg.<sup>10</sup>

Sometime prior to the 1910 census, Cora and William separated or divorced, and from 1912-1914 Cora lived with William's mother, Mrs. Mary A. Wennell, at 26 Balm Street. From 1915-1916 Cora lived with a Mrs. Wennell and Cora's daughter, Jean, at 28 North Summit Street. While living there Jean was a clerk in a store.<sup>11</sup>

Shortly after 1916 Cora married John Edward Geistwhite, who was born March 5<sup>th</sup> 1874 to John H. Geistwhite and Rosey B. Fentzel in Pennsylvania.<sup>12</sup> John was a machinist working for a machine shop in York Pennsylvania.

- John was first married to Minerva (Minnie) E. Smith on July 8<sup>th</sup> 1898.<sup>13</sup> Minnie was born September 2<sup>nd</sup> 1878. She was 31 years old when she died June 7<sup>th</sup> 1910 in York Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest June 9<sup>th</sup> 1910 at the Green Mount Cemetery York Pennsylvania.<sup>14</sup> FAG#88460031<sup>iii</sup>
- John Geistwhite and Minnie Smith had two children
  - a. John Edward Geistwhite was born April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1901. He married Alfretta G. Musser, who was born July 6<sup>th</sup> 1902. Alfretta died June 28<sup>th</sup> 1981 (FAG#13016302), and John was 88 years old when he died February 19<sup>th</sup> 1990 (FAG#13016296) in Palmyra Dauphin County. They were both laid to rest at the Hummelstown Cemetery located in Hummelstown Dauphin County Pennsylvania.

John and Dorothy had two children: James E. Geistwhite and Dorothy G Lorenz.<sup>15</sup>

b. Lydia (Liddie) E. Geistwhite was born October 30<sup>th</sup> 1908.<sup>16</sup> She was 27 years old when she married 36 year old William Cawardin Russell July 2<sup>nd</sup> 1937 in Harrisburg Dauphin County. William was born June 11<sup>th</sup> 1901 to John J. Russell and Rosalia Temmons<sup>17</sup> in Columbia Lancaster County Pennsylvania.

- John J. Russell was born 1856 to Thomas Russell and Bridget Kelly in Marietta Lancaster county Pennsylvania. He married Rosalia Apnes Temmons, who was born February 12<sup>th</sup> 1872 at Mt. Rock Cumberland County Pennsylvania to Matthew Temmons of Ireland and Mary Will of Pennsylvania.<sup>18</sup>
- John died November 11<sup>th</sup> 1935 from a coronary embolism. He was laid to rest November 14<sup>th</sup> 1935 at the Saint Peters Roman Catholic Cemetery, 801 Old Chickies Hill Road, Columbia Lancaster County Pennsylvania. FAG#143529605
- Rosalia Apnes Semmons was 70 years old when she died October 12<sup>th</sup> 1942 while living at her home, 2026 North 6<sup>th</sup> Street, in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Rosalia was laid to rest October 15<sup>th</sup> 1942 in Conewago Township Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Her daughter, Mary B. Russell lived with Rosalia, and was the informant on her death certificate.<sup>19</sup>

William died June 2<sup>nd</sup> 1959 from a coronary embolism, at his home, 2743 Herr Street Harrisburg. He was laid to rest June 5<sup>th</sup> 1959 at the Holy Cross Cemetery in Harrisburg.<sup>20</sup> FAG#9296875

Lydia died August 10<sup>th</sup> 2001,<sup>21</sup> and was laid to rest at the Hummelstown Cemetery located in Hummelstown Dauphin County Pennsylvania. FAG#13016290

By 1920 Cora and John Geistwhite lived in the same home and 3<sup>rd</sup> precinct of Harrisburg, as she did with her husband William Wennell; 38 Summit Street. With them are the John's children, Edward and Liddie Geistwhite.

By 1930 Cora and her husband John lived next door to her daughter Jean Wennel-Garrett. John Geistwhite was 56 years old when he died June 14<sup>th</sup> 1930 at his home on Summit Street in Penbrook Dauphin County Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest June 17<sup>th</sup> 1930, next to his first wife Minnie, at the Green Mount Cemetery<sup>iv</sup> in York Pennsylvania.<sup>22</sup> FAG#143350489

After John died Cora moved in with her daughter, Jean Garrett, and her family.

Cora was 80 years old when she died June 24<sup>th</sup> 1950 while living at 27 Butler Street in Penbrook Dauphin County Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest June 28<sup>th</sup> 1950 in the Churchville Cemetery in Oberlin, Dauphin County Pennsylvania.<sup>23</sup> FAG#91866079<sup>v</sup>

Cora and John Geistwhite did not have any children together.

- i. Mary C. Wennell was born January 1896 in Harrisburg, Dauphin County Pennsylvania. She died of Cholera on June 27<sup>th</sup> 1896.<sup>24</sup> We're still locating her burial location.<sup>vi</sup> FAG#

Jean M. Wennell was born March 24<sup>th</sup> 1898 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.<sup>26</sup> Jean married Charles Sherman Garrett,<sup>27</sup> who was born 1897.

Jean was 51 years old when she died June 13<sup>th</sup> 1949 in Harrisburg. She was laid to rest June 16<sup>th</sup> 1949 with her husband in the Churchville Cemetery in Oberlin Dauphin County Pennsylvania.<sup>28</sup>

Sherman died in 1957.<sup>29</sup> FAG#91866042

Jean and Sherman Garret had three children.

- i. Robert Keen Garrett was born June 29<sup>th</sup> 1918.<sup>30</sup> He was an insurance salesman living with his parents at 24 Butler Street in Penbrook, Harrisburg Pennsylvania.

He was previously married, but divorced his wife on October 1<sup>st</sup> 1945.<sup>31</sup> He was 27 years old when he married his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife, 23 year old Lucille Mae Poole on November 30<sup>th</sup> 1945 in Middletown Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Lucy was born 1922 to Emory R. Poole and Sarah Wolf in Camp Hill Cumberland County. At the time of her marriage she worked as a typist, and lived in New Cumberland.<sup>32</sup>

Robert died June 8<sup>th</sup> 2000 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania.<sup>33</sup> He was laid to rest at the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery located in Anville, Lebanon County Pennsylvania.
