

Regina Mary Agle (1879-1945)

Regina Mary Agle was born March 17th 1879 to Edward Tobias Agle and Anna Catherine Graham ¹ in Shippensburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ²

Regina was 19 years old when she married 26 year old Harry Grant Seitz on December 22nd 1898 in Shippensburg Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ³

At the time of their marriage, Harry worked as a brakeman on the railroad, and lived in Shippensburg. Harry Grant Seitz was born February 19th 1872 to John H. Seitz and Mary Smith in Mt. Rock , near Shippensburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania. ⁴

After Regina and Harry married the family moved to 22 Brady Avenue in the 9th ward Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. By 1922 Regina and Harry lived at 2109 Moore Street in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. She was a onetime President of the Women's Benefit Association.

Regina was 65 years old when she died at her home, 2109 Moore Street, February 8th 1945. ⁷ She was laid to rest February 12th 1945 at the Rolling Green Cemetery in Camp Hill Cumberland County Pennsylvania. Her son, Edward L. Seitz, was the informant on her death certificate. FAG#138461412 ⁱ

Harry was 74 years old when he died at his home, 2109 Moore Street, September 18th 1946. He was laid to rest September 21st 1946, next to his wife, at the Rolling Green Cemetery in Camp Hill. ⁹ His son, Harry G. Seitz, was the informant on his death certificate. FAG# 138461661 ⁱⁱ

Regina Agle and Harry Seitz had 8 men and 2 women.¹⁰

- i. Walter Agle Seitz was born July 17th 1899¹¹ to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle. He was in the 1900-1910 family censuses.

Like his father, he was a brakeman for the railroad. Walter was 19 years old when he married Carrie Belle Clingan, January 30th 1919, in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Carrie was born 1900 in Carroll County Maryland to George W. Clingan of Carroll County Maryland, and Fannie A. Yingling of Mayberry Maryland.¹²

On January 5th 1900 Carrie showed up in the 1920 census record living with Harry and Regina. By April 16th 1920 Walter and Carrie lived at 2010 Wood Street in Harrisburg.

Walter was 65 years old when he died April 1964.¹³ Walter Seitz and Carrie Clingan children:

- a. Walter D. Seitz was born 1910 to Walter and Carrie Seitz in Harrisburg Pennsylvania.
- b. Virginia M. Seitz was born 1913 to Walter and Carrie Seitz in Harrisburg Pennsylvania.
- c. June Elizabeth Seitz¹⁴ was born June 2nd 1924¹⁵ in Harrisburg Pennsylvania to Walter A. Seitz and Carrie B. Clingan. June was 19 years old when she married 19 year old Emil Robert Weiss on December 20th 1945 in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Emil was born 1924 to Emil Weiss and Elizabeth Snyder.¹⁶

June also married next to Arthur L. Sprenkle, who died in 1992, and then to James G. Norton. The most important things in June's life were her faith and spending time with her family.

June was 85 years old when she died March 20th 2010 at the Woods at Cedar Run in Lower Allen Township Cumberland County Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest in the Rolling Green Cemetery located in Camp Hill Pennsylvania. FAG#106777138

- e. Mildred Regina Seitz was born May 4th 1921. She was 1 year, 1 month, and 9 days old when she died at her parent's home of measles on June 13th 1922. She was laid to rest June 15th 1922 at the East Harrisburg Cemetery in Harrisburg Pennsylvania.¹⁷ FAG#143632869ⁱⁱⁱ

- f. Norman Richard Seitz was born March 19th 1927. He was 7 days old when he died from complications of a premature birth. ^{iv} Norman was laid to rest at the East Harrisburg Cemetery in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. ¹⁸ FAG# 143633033 ^v
- ii. Lamonte E. Seitz was born 1903 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. He was with the family in the 1910-1920 censuses, but not the 1930. He may have gone to Allegany County Pennsylvania.
- iii. Harry Grant Seitz was born 1905 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. He was with the family in the 1910-1930 censuses.
- iv. Ruth P. Seitz was born 1906 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. She was with the family in the 1910-1930 censuses.
- v. Katherine A. Seitz was born 1908 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. She may also have gone by the name, Anna Catherine. Anna was 19 years old when she married 25 year old Robert N. Longacre on May 27th 1927 in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Robert was born 1902 to Harry Longacre and Elizabeth Newman. ¹⁹ Their son is Robert B. Longacre who was born in 1932.
- vi. Kenneth Paul (Paul Kenneth) Seitz was born May 1909 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. He was with the family in the 1910-1930 censuses.

Like his father Paul was a brakeman for the railroad. Ken was 25 years old when he married 19 year old Gladys Ruth Reasey January 5th 1935 in Camp Hill Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

Gladys was born 1916 at Baker's Summit in Bedford County Pennsylvania to Grover C. Reasey of New Enterprise Bedford County, and Anna May Long of Baker's Summit. Grover was a salesman living in Tower City Dauphin County Pennsylvania, and Anna had died at the time of the marriage. ²⁰

- v. Dorothy Regina Seitz was born July 11th 1911 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg. She was 7 months and 14 days old when she died of diphtheria February 25th 1912, and was laid to rest on the same day at the Harrisburg Cemetery. ²¹ FAG#143633489 ^{vi}
- vi. Unnamed Named Male Seitz: The child was still born to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle on October 21st 1914. The child was laid to rest the same day at the Harrisburg Cemetery. ²² FAG#143633826
- vii. Howard (Pop) Martin Seitz was born June 10th 1917 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. ²³

Howard 1st married Gladys Lesh, and 2nd to Enid Lucas, and for a time he lived in Carlisle Cumberland County Pennsylvania.

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Howard retired from Western Electric Company after 36 years of service as an Installation Supervisor. He was a member of the Pennsylvania National Guard, from 1934 to 1937. The most vivid recollection of his service was the 48 days he served on horse patrol and security in Harrisburg during the 1936 Susquehanna River flood.

He was a World War II Army Veteran, first assigned to the 155th Howitzer Battalion. The unit trained mules used to transport guns into the Italian Mountains Terrain, which were inaccessible to vehicles. The war in Europe concluded and his unit was then converted to the 421st Rocket Battalion for service in Okinawa.

Howard was an avid small game and deer hunter on the D.W. Lesh farm, near Ickesburg, Perry County. He later owned and lived on 19 acres of the Lesh homestead. Afterwards, he was a 12 year resident of LaTort Manor, at the Church of God Home in Carlisle.

He was an enthusiastic fan of the New York Yankees and even had the pleasure of seeing Babe Ruth play. He was a dedicated member of the many Bowling Leagues until he retired. One cannot mention "Pop" without making note of his enjoyment going to the Casinos in Atlantic City and Harrisburg.

Howard was 96 years old when he died Thursday evening September 5th 2013 while living in Millerstown, Juanita County Pennsylvania. Funeral Services were held at 11am, Tuesday, September 10th 2013, at Hetrick-Bitner Funeral Home, 3125 Walnut St., Harrisburg, PA 17109. Viewing will be held from 10am until time of services. Burial was at Rolling Green Cemetery. FAG#116728209 ^{vii}

Leon was 26 years old when he married 24 year old Irene C. Campbell on November 11th 1944 in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. Irene was born in 1920 to Brady Fuller and Ruth Campbell. ²⁵

Leon and Irene lived in rural south Lebanon in Lebanon County Pennsylvania. Leon was 42 years old when he died of septicemia at the Veterans Hospital in Lebanon September 29th 1960. He was laid to rest October 3rd at East Harrisburg Cemetery in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. ²⁶ FAG#125165020 ^{ix} Irene died in 2020, and was laid to rest next to her husband at the East Harrisburg Cemetery. - vii. Lester Seitz was born a twin April 14th 1918 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. He was with the family in the 1920-1930 censuses. Lester married Martha May Garman,²⁷ and they lived on West Chocolate Avenue in Hershey Pennsylvania.

Martha was born September 12th 1920. She was a WWII veteran, and achieved the rank of being a Master Sergeant in the US Marine Corps.²⁸

Lester was a WWII veteran and worked for the McFarland Printing Company in Harrisburg. Lester and Martha were members of the Derry Street Gospel Chapel in Lawnton.^x

Martha died November 8th 1998, and was laid to rest in Plot: 14, 0, 195 of the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery in Annville.²⁹ FAG#1168433

Lester was 84 years old when he died Thursday, April 18th 2002 at his home. His funeral services and burial was held April 23rd 2002. He was laid to rest at the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery in Annville. FAG#18753940

They had a son, Daniel Seitz of Carlisle, who had a child, Amber L. Seitz of Carlisle.³⁰

- viii. Robert G. Seitz was born 1925 to Harry Grant Seitz and Regina May Agle in Harrisburg Pennsylvania. He was with the family in the 1930 census. Robert married Vera, and they were still living in Huntington Beach California 2013 when his brother Howard died.³¹
