JMS_(28)	Simon Sollenberger family: See JMS_(27 and 27A), back row 2 nd person from the right in the the photo and JMS_(29). Other family members are also in Sollenberger family reunion photo, photo.
JMS_(29 - 29A)	William J. Sollenberger, same person in JMS_(28), back row 2 nd from the left, this photo appears to be a soldier, Marine strips (Sergeant). He is young in the photo, and may be from the Spanish American conflict. William died in 1916. Simon lives with William's wife and children.
JMS_(29B)	Earl R. Sollenberger. He was a marine Sergeant, and he may be the same person as in JMS_(29) The photo was obtained from the Find-A-Grave Web Site.
JMS_(30 - 30A)	Levi Sollenberger Family; He is the same person standing behind, and to the left, of Mary Diller-Sollenberger sitting in the wheelchair of the photo JMS_(21 and 21A) and his wife in JMS_(22 and 22A). They are also in the Sollenberger family reunion photo, JMS_(31 to 31F)

JMS_(31 - 31C) Sollenberger Family Reunion, Summer of 1910 or 1911, Mary Ann Diller-Sollenberger died January 1913; taken at Mary Ann Diller-Sollenberger home at the intersection of present day Union Church Road and South Mountain Road Franklin Township Dillsburg PA. Mary Diller-Sollenberger's husband Jacob died in 1899. Mary and some of her children are in the picture: Catherine died in 1882; Simon is not in the photo but his sons are; Diller and his wife and children are in the photo; Levi and his wife are in the photo; Abraham died in 1864; Anna and her husband Tobias and children are in the photo; Alice and her children are in the photo, but his wife Anna is; and Julia is in the photo.

Left to Right-1st Row: Paul Wrightstone Hattie and Edwin Wrightstone's son; Ruth Reed the daughter of Naomie Sollenberger-Reed, daughter of Diller Sollenberger; Ruth Wrightstone Hattie and Edwin Wrightstone's daughter; Mary Ann Diller-Sollenberger, wife of Jacob Sollenberger and matriarch of the Sollenberger family, she died January 1913, about 5 months after the reunion; Mary Reed another daughter of Naomie Sollenberger-Reed, daughter of Diller Sollenberger; Clara Knaub, daughter of Alice Sollenberger-Knaub

Left to Right-2nd Row: behind Paul Wrightstone- Charles Sollenberger, the son of Diller Sollenberger's son, Clinton; the two girls are Anna and her sister Ester Sollenberger, the daughters of Maurice, who is the son of Simon Sollenberger; on the other side of Mary Diller-Sollenberger is Margaret Bentz, who is the daughter of Anna Sollenberger-Bentz; Irene Wrightstone who is the daughter of Hattie and Edwin Wrightstone, my grandmother; Ira Knaub standing in front of his older sister Ellen and mother Alice Sollenberger-Knaub
