### *Raymond Chester Wrightstone (RCW) married Francis Kelly*

If there was anything written anywhere on the front or back of the photo, it will be recorded in the photo descriptions described below. Photo dates are estimates (c-circa) based on a number of factors; knowing a person and estimating their age in the photos, clothing styles, photographic techniques, etc.

Raymond and Francis Wrightstone's children: Judy who married Muth, and Sandra (Sandy)

- RCW\_(07A) Stamped on the back of the photo: James Lett Co February 8 1946, probably taken in late summer 1945 – Monroe Wrightstone holding the horse at the Wrightstone Lemoyne farm; Left to Right-Girls Standing: Monroe Wrightstone’s daughter Joyce, Raymond Wrightstone’s daughter Judy, and Monroe’s daughter Beverly; Left to Right on Pony: Jim Wrightstone’s wife Dot’s niece Marilyn, Ralph Wrightstone’s son Ralph Jr. (Sonny), Monroe’s son Monroe Jr. and daughter Diane
- RCW\_(07B) 1946 – At the Edwin Wrightstone’s Lemoyne farm; Left of the well pump is Judy – Raymond’s oldest daughter; and on the right is Marilyn; Jim Wrightstone’s wife Dot’s niece
- RCW\_(08 to 08P) The 1951 photos are of Sandy Wrightstone’s birthday party; Raymond and Francis Wrightstone’s youngest daughter
- #08 Left to Right: Birthday girl Sandy, and her sister Judy
- #08A to #08H: Birthday girl Sandy Wrightstone
- #08I - Left to Right: Sandy, Agnes (Aggie) who is Francis Wrightstone’s twin sister, and Judy Wrightstone
- #08J - Left to Right: Evelyn Myers-Hartman, a friend of Frances and Aggie, and Aggie who is Francis Wrightstone’s twin sister
- #08K - Left to Right around the table: Jimmy Weber who is Hazel Moyer Wrightstone’s sister, Helen Moyer-Weber’s son; Julia Wrightstone-Edmunds holding her daughter Marsha, the birthday girl Sue Wrightstone; Judy Wrightstone -Raymond and Francis Wrightstone’s daughter; Sue’s Sister Linda Wrightstone; and Julia’s other daughter Sharon Edmunds
- #08L are the same folks as in #08K, plus the little girl with her back to the camera, who is Ann Hartman. Ann is the daughter of Evelyn Kelley-Hartman, who is the sister of Sandy’s mother Francis Kelley-Wrightstone.
- #08M - Left to Right around the table: Jimmy Weber who is Hazel Moyer Wrightstone’s sister, Helen Moyer-Weber’s son; Edwin Wrightstone; Sue Wrightstone; and with their faces not shown next to Sue are Judy Wrightstone; Sue’s Sister Linda Wrightstone; and Julia’s other daughter Sharon Edmunds; and standing with the apron on is Hazel Moyer-Wrightstone, Sue’s and Linda’s mother.
- #08N - Left to Right: Birthday girl Sandy Wrightstone; Annie Kelly leaning over helping Vicki Zutell; in the highchair is \_\_\_\_\_being helped by Linda Kelley; the lady sitting next to the high chair is Agnes Kelly with her husband George Kelly, and his granddaughter Ann Hartman. The photo is of Francis Kelly Wrightstone’s parents and their daughters and grandchildren.
- #08O - Left to right around the table: a hidden face, Sharon Edmunds, Gertrude Palmer-Kelly, George Kelly’s mother, and the birthday girl Sandy’s Great Grandmother; Raymond is standing at the corner of the table, birthday girl Sandy, Annie Kelly; Agnes and George Kelly; Ann Hartman; and Jimmy Weber with his head to the camera.
- #08P – Raymond Wrightstone with Jimmy Weber who is Hazel Moyer Wrightstone’s sister, Helen Moyer-Weber’s son

- RCW\_(09) Left is Raymond Wrightstone and to the right is Edwin Klinger at a Wrightstone reunion on the Yellow Breeches. The reunion was held near Bowmansdale on York Road, just over the Yellow Breeches Bridge on the left, Monaghan Township York County PA. The creek is visible in the back ground. Siddonsburg is half mile down the road, which is where Edwin Wrightstone lived as a child. The Wrightstone family farmed the land surrounding the reunion site.
