Ruth and Ken Miller did not have any children together. Ken did have a son from a previous marriage.

REW_(01 and 01A)	My thoughts: Ruth was out driving around the country side, note the mountain ridge in the background
REW_(02) Lemoyne farm	Written on the back of #02; looks like Ruth, but I'm not sure; I think it is Ruth on the
REW_(03 to 03D)	#03. On the back of photo: I love my sweet pop ee; a reference to her father?
	# 03A to 03D is Ruth Wrightstone c. 1925 about 17 years old
	#03C and 03D is Ruth, most likely where the road to the Lemoyne farm intersects with present day Cumberland Road and Indiana Avenue in Lemoyne PA
REW_(03E and 03F)	From the same role of film; Photo #03E is Ruth, and #03F is her girl friend. Look at the REW_(06A, and07 to 09) series of photos, and you will see the same girl in other photos.
REW_(04)	#04; written on the back of photo, Ruth with skipper
REW_(06 to 06B)	#06 is Ruth Wrightstone and #06A and 06B is Ruth with one of her girl friends. Look at the REW_(03F, and07 to 09) series of photos, and you will see the same girl in other photos.
REW_(07 and 07B)	The photos are from the same roll of film; Written on the back of #07, Ruth, Oyster Farm; #07A Sara Walters-Feister; #07B is the same person on #07A. Sara Walters-Feister went to church with Julia Wrightstone-Edmunds family at the Mt. Zion E.U.B. Church (now United Methodist) on the Wertzville Road. Sara married Art Feister who lived next door to Julia's family on State Street in Lemoyne. The Walters Family lived close to Mt. Zion and had several kids. The children went to high school together at Enola High School too, I believe. Sara's brother was Rev. Clarence G. Walters, United Methodist minister.

REW_(07E) circa 1936, Ruth Wrightstone's friends; On the back of photo: Fay Windom Souder and

Ruth Wrightstone at either Grove or Willow Mills. 2nd from the right is Ruth

Wrightstone. Is Fay standing in front of her? There were to parks she was referring to; Williams Grove and Willow Mills. The Roller Coaster in the background would not have

been at Williams Grove, the Comet.
