

## Michael Wrightstone (MW) and Eliza Kline Photo Index

Michael Wrightstone married Eliza Jane Kline, and they had nine children:

- i. Ulysses S. Grant Wrightstone: known as Grant, he was born June 7<sup>th</sup> 1866, and died October 20<sup>th</sup> 1943
- ii. Ira Alfred Wrightstone: born June 11<sup>th</sup> 1867, and died June 27<sup>th</sup> 1953
- iii. William Elmer Wrightstone: born December 7<sup>th</sup> 1868
- iv. Charles Howard Wrightstone: born March 28<sup>th</sup> 1870, and died February 20<sup>th</sup> 1871
- v. Franklin Marion Wrightstone: born January 20<sup>th</sup> 1872, and died in 1929
- vi. Edwin Underwood Wrightstone: born August 20<sup>th</sup> 1874, and died August 21<sup>st</sup> 1957
- vii. Irwin Caleb Wrightstone: born July 11<sup>th</sup> 1878, and died in 1931 and is buried in Enola
- viii. Maurice Percy Wrightstone: born February 17<sup>th</sup> 1880, WWI registration from Nebraska
- ix. Ida May Wrightstone: Born July 6<sup>th</sup> 1885, Married Jonathan I. May, February 2<sup>nd</sup> 1904 Mechanicsburg

- MW (01) Fileys Church and Cemetery on Fileys Road in Monaghan Township York County Pennsylvania, near Dillsburg Pennsylvania; The church burned down in 2010. Michael Wrightstone, his wife, and son Charles Howard Wrightstone are buried in this cemetery, Michael's daughter Ida May Wrightstone-May, her husband, and daughter, and Michael's brother John and his wife and children Jonathan.
- MW (01A) Fileys Church cemetery entrance, and MW (01B) is a distant shot to his brother's, John Wrightstone's, family headstones
- MW (02) Michael, Eliza, and Charles Wrightstone's headstone located at Filey's Church Cemetery  
MW (02A) is a close up of the top of the stone, and MW (02C) is a closer view of the inscription.
- MW (03) This is a photo of a very large poster of the 166<sup>th</sup> Regimental Memorial Roster, which is the regiment that Michael was assigned to during the Civil War. A closer look and you can read Michael's name.
- MW (04) This is a 1876 Monaghan Township Map, identifying the names of roads as they were in 2010, and it identifies the home location of Michael Wrightstone's family.
