BE IT REMEMBERED, That before the Prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas for the said county of York, on the *first* day of *June* in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and *Sixty eight* personally appeared *Jacob*

*Schleich* who being sworn according to law, doth declare and say, that it is his bona fide intention to become A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and to renounce and abjure entirely and absolutely all allegiance and fidelity to every Foreign Prince, Potentate, State or Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to ~~*Frederick William*~~ *The King of Prussia* of whom he is now or was lately a subject.
