

David K. Einzig (1849-1911)

David K. Einzig ¹ was born August 24th 1850 ² to Anton Einzig and Eleanora Blum ³ in the Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania.

David was 21 years old when he married 19 year old Cassandra (Catherine) ⁱ Killmeyer ⁱⁱ February 15th 1870 at the St. James Church in York, York County Pennsylvania. Cassandra was born September 1st 1850 to Jacob Killinger in Maryland. ⁱⁱⁱ Jacob was born in Germany. ⁴

David was a brush maker, and the family lived in the village of Freystown, next to his sisters, Catherine who married Leo Mayer, and Theresa who married Fredrick Myers.

By 1900 the family lived at Ridge Avenue in York Pennsylvania, and later at 51 Ridge Avenue York Pennsylvania. ^{iv} In 1910 his sister Katherine Myers, a widow, lived next door to the family.

Cassandra was 59 years old and living with David at 51 Ridge Avenue in York when she died from Tuberculosis on January 12th 1911. She was laid to rest January 14th 1911 at the St. Mary's Cemetery ^v in Violet Hill York Pennsylvania. Leo Einzig was the informant on her death certificate. ⁵ Leo was the son of David's brother, Herman Einzig. ⁶ FAG#: ^{vi}

David was 61 years old living at 51 Ridge Avenue in York Pennsylvania, when he died from Arterial Sclerosis on October 9th 1911. He was laid to rest October 11th 1911 at the the St. Mary's Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Leo Einzig was the informant on her death certificate. ⁷ Leo was the son of David's brother, Herman Einzig. ⁸

- David's entire estate went to his wife Catherine, who was also the executor on the will. His sister Catherine Einzig-Mayer, and her husband Leo Mayer. David's daughter, Ella Einsig was also a witness, as well as signing for her Aunt Catherine Mayer. ⁹

David and Cassandra had ten children. ^{vii}

- i. Catharine Einsig was born in 1873. She was living with the family in 1880, but by 1900 we could not located her.

ⁱ Cassandra was also spelled as Lucinda, Tassie, Katrantha, and Catherien was written on David's will.

ⁱⁱ Other spellings of Cassandra's last name: Killinger, Kilmyer, Killymore, Kilman, and Gilmore.

ⁱⁱⁱ In her daughter's and son's, Lena and Leo Einsig's death certificate, Cassandra's birth place was identified as Holland.

- ii. Elenora Einsig was born 1875 in the Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania. She married Mr. Stough. Elenora was 35 years old, living as a widow at 45 East Church Street in York Pennsylvania, when she died October 19th 1913. She was laid to rest September 22nd 1913 at the St Mary's cemetery in York. Milton H. Jacob was the informant. ¹⁰

- iii. Philbert J. Einsig was born October 31st 1876 in the Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania. He was 29 years old and never married. He worked for Standard Chain, when he died from Typhoid Fever on December 28th 1915 at the York Hospital in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest December 31st 1915 at the Greenmount Cemetery in York. ¹¹

- iv. Rosa (Rosella or Rosie) E. Einsig was born January 22nd 1878 ^x in the Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania. She married Daniel S. Cover on December 23rd 1895 in Carroll County Maryland. ¹² She died June 28th 1931 at the York Hospital in York Pennsylvania. Rosella was laid to rest July 1st 1931 in the Greenmount Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. John M. Cover was the informant on her death certificate. ¹³ FAG#: ^{xi}
- v. Teresa Einsig was born a twin on January 25th 1880 in the village of Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania.
- vi. Lena (Magdalena) M. Einsig was born a twin on January 25th 1880 in the village of Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania. She married Stanley M. Foller. The family lived at 719 State Street in York. Lena was 67 year old widow when she died January 2nd 1948 at the home of her brother Leo Einsig on rural route 2 Dillsburg in Warrington Township York County. She was laid to rest January 6th 1948 at the Mt. Rose cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Edward Foller was the informant on her death certificate. ¹⁴ FAG#: ^{xii}
- vii. Henry G Einsig was born September 25th 1882 in the village of Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania. He was a widower, living with his daughter Susan R. Zepp at 7 North Newberry Street in York, when he died February 21st 1952. Henry was laid to rest February 22nd 1953 in the Prospect Hill Cemetery located in Manchester Township York County. His daughter Susan R. Zepp and Reverend Guy B. Creep were the informants on the death certificate. ¹⁵ FAG#: ^{xiii}
- viii. Lillian was born in September 1882

- ix. Leo Einsig was born December 16th 1884 in the village of Freystown area of Spring Garden, York County Pennsylvania.

Leo was married to Blanch, and they lived on rural route 2 Dillsburg in Warrington Township York County. Leo was 64 years old when he died of a cerebral hemorrhage in the town of Dillsburg on January 21st 1949. Leo was laid to rest January 24th 1949 at the Prospect Hill Cemetery Manchester Township in York Pennsylvania. Guy B. Creep was the informant on the death certificate. ¹⁶ FAG#: ^{xiv}

- x. Feetie Einsig was born November 1885
- xi. Annie L. Einsig was born March 1890. She married Mr. Test, and they had one child. 1910 Annie was living with her parents, but not Mr. Test or the child.
