

Johannes George Einzigⁱ (1830-1915)

Johannes (John) George Einzig¹ was born March 23rd 1830² to David Einzig (b.1907) and Barbara Rupp (Ruff)³ in the village

Vollmaringen Horb Wurttemberg germany

Vollmaringen is about 8 miles (13.7km) north of Ahldorf Ahldorf,ⁱⁱ located in the Schwarzwald Kreisⁱⁱⁱ of Württemberg^{iv} Germany. Horb am Necter is a few miles west of Ahldoef

Vollmaringen is about 17 miles east of Ruesten

of Ruesten^v located in the Schwarzwald Kreis^{vi} of Württemberg^{vii} Germany⁴

Johannes Einzig was 12 years old when he arrived at the port of Baltimore with his family on December 22nd 1843. Their place of origin was identified as Ruesten.^{viii} Their destination was identified as Pennsylvania.⁵ According to the 1910 census record, John immigrated in 1833^{ix} and in 1850 he was naturalized in York County Pennsylvania.

John's mother, Barbara Rupp (Ruff), was 34 years old, and was born about 1809. His brother, David Einsig was 13 years old, Maria Einsig was 8 years old, Albert Einsig was 2 years old, and Mathias Einsig was 1 ½ years old.

John married Theresa (Rose) Findling^x June 2nd 1850 in York County Pennsylvania.⁶ Theresa must have been previously married to a Findling. She was born Theresa Berger on March 8th 1834 to Conrad Berger and Grace Wolf in Germany.⁷ In the 1900 census record Theresa indicated she immigrated in 1841.⁸

- All the children identified John Einsig as their father, except the name of their mother was different: Andrew on his marriage and death certificate indicated Teresa Berger, Catherine's death certificate indicated Theresa Berger; Lizzie death certificate indicated Teresa Findley; Ida indicated Teresa Berger; John indicated Theresa Berger; Ellen indicted Athena; Mary indicated Teresa Findley.

John stood 5' 7" tall and had dark hair and dark eyes when he enlisted in York on September 9th 1861 during the Civil War.⁹ He was assigned to Company "C" of the 87th Pennsylvania Infantry.^{xi} As the regiment was ordered into the field, John deserted June 22nd 1862. He may have been held in confinement in Harrisburg until March 27th 1863.¹⁰ He mustered out of the 87th on June 22nd 1863.¹¹

John then enlisted in Harrisburg with Company "A" of the 49th Pennsylvania Infantry,^{xii} serving at the rank of private between June 4th 1863 and July 15th 1865.¹²

Son of David & Barbara Ruff Aensich and husband of Theresa Findling (Berger), whom he married June 2, 1850, in York. In 1860, he was a basket maker living in Freystown, Spring Garden Township, York County. He stood 5' 7" tall and had dark hair and dark eyes. His age is subject to debate. Using his stated age at death of 84-10-7, that calculates to a birth date of February 28, 1830, but the 1850 census says he was 35.

A Civil War veteran, who enlisted in York September 9, 1861, with Co. C, 87th Pa Inf. However, he deserted June 22, 1862, as the regiment was ordered into the field. After his desertion, supposedly was in confinement in Harrisburg as of March 27, 1863, but further status unknown. Also enrolled in Harrisburg with Co. A, 49th Pa Inf, serving at the rank of private June 4, 1863 - July 15, 1865. His name on the 87th Pa rolls is spelled "Ensigg" and with the 49th Pa, "Ensick."

John was a basket maker, and lived his entire life in the in the Freystown^{xiii} area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. In 1900 the family lived with two of their sons, Andrew and John, at 26 Sherman Street in York Pennsylvania.

Theresa was about 71 years old when she died March 8th 1907 while living at 204 South Sherman Street in York Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest March 11th 1907 at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York, York County Pennsylvania. Leona Luckenbach was the informant on the death certificate.¹³

John was 84 years old, just shy of his 85th birthday, when he died January 7th 1915 and was laid to rest June 10th 1915 at the Prospect Hill cemetery, Section I, Lot 156,¹⁴ in York, York County Pennsylvania. His son Andrew was the informant on the death certificate.¹⁵ FAG#:53428704^{xv}

- i. Mary E. Einzig was born December 15th 1850 in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.¹⁶ She married George Minehart September 11th 1869 at the Christ Lutheran Church in York, York County Pennsylvania.¹⁷ George was born March 16th 1830 to Lawrence Minehart in Pennsylvania. Both of George's parents were born in Germany.¹⁸

George lived at 733 East Edison Street in York Pennsylvania when he died April 30th 1929. He was laid to rest May 3rd 1929 at the Mt. Rose cemetery in York. His wife Mary was the informant on his death certificate.¹⁹ FAG#:70227270^{xvi}

Mary was 82 years old when she died July 24th 1933 while living with her daughter at 221 Patterson Street in York. She was laid to rest July 27th 1933 at Mt. Rose cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Fredrick New was the informant on her death certificate.²⁰ FAG#:70227271^{xvii}

- ii. Anna Einzig was born about 1852. She was in the 1860, but not the 1870 census record.
- iii. Catherina Einzig was born June 8th 1859 in Baltimore Maryland. She married George New.²¹ Catherine was 79 years old when she died September 22nd 1938 while living at 12 South Lee

Street in York Pennsylvania. She was laid to rest September 29th 1938 at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York. Sadie Peterson was the informant on her death certificate.²²

- iv. Elizabeth Einzig was born April 30th 1860 in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania.²³ She married Ferdinand Myers on March 26th 1877 at the Christ Lutheran Church in York, York County Pennsylvania.²⁴

Ferdinand was born February 9th 1856 to Ludwig and Mary Myers in Switzerland. Ludwig and Mary were both born in Switzerland.²⁵ Ferdinand was a basket maker and horse dealer.

In 1880 and 1900 lived next door to her sister Mary Minehart and brother John Einsig, and her cousin Eleanor^{xviii} (Ellen) Scharp (Sharp) on Sherman Street in York.

Elizabeth was 60 years old when she died January 2nd 1927 while living at 741 East Edison Street York Pennsylvania. Elizabeth was laid to rest January 5th 1927 at the Mt. Rose cemetery in Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. Louisa N. Nicholas was the informant on her death certificate.²⁶ FAG#:150044865

Ferdinand lived in the rear of 741 Edison Street in York, and later he went to live at the York County home in Springettsbury Township in York County Pennsylvania. It was there, at 85 years old, when he died September 27th 1941. He was laid to rest with his wife on September 30th 1941 at the Mt. Rose cemetery. Perry Snell, superintendent of the York County home, was the informant on the death certificate.²⁷ FAG#: 150992013^{xix}

In 1900 Lizzie indicated she had seven children, but only three were still living.

- v. John William^{xx} Einzig was born December 18th 1871.²⁸ He married Elizabeth Ritter.²⁹
- vi. Ellen Einzig was born January 17th 1861 in the Freystown area of Spring Garden Township York County Pennsylvania. She married Curtis Kleiman. The family lived in the York city area. On March 10th 1934, while living at 823 East Poplar Street York Pennsylvania, Ellen died t 72 years old. She was laid to rest March 14th 1934 at the Mt. Rose cemetery in York. Her son Elmer Kleiman was the informant on her death certificate.³⁰
- vii. Andrew Einzig was born March 17th 1869 in York Pennsylvania.³¹ Andrew and Ella N. New applied for a marriage license on May 7th 1889.³² The family lived at 204 South Sherman Street in York. Andrew was 76 years old when he died at home on December 6th 1945. He was laid to rest December 10th 1945 at the Mt. Rose cemetery in Spring Garden Township York Pennsylvania. His son Andrew J. Einsig was the informant on Andrew's death certificate.³³

Golden.³⁴ She was 76 years old, living at 431 West Princess Street in York Pennsylvania, when she died January 16th 1947. She was laid to rest January 20th 1947 at the Greenmount cemetery in York County Pennsylvania. Raymond M. Golden was the informant on her death certificate.³⁵
