## Albert Franklin Heckert (1832-1897)

Albert Franklin Heckert was born about 1832 <sup>2</sup> to Jacob Heckert Sr. and Mary Salome in York County Pennsylvania. Jacob and Mary were deceased when their son Albert died in 1897. <sup>3</sup>

In 1850 Albert lived with his mother, Mary (Sarah) Heckert (b.1795 in PA) in the North Ward of York, York County Pennsylvania. They were living in the home of Daniel Heckert (b.1825 in PA) and his wife Emily (b. 1826 in PA), and their son Daniel (b.1849 in PA). Samuel and his brother Albert were tinsmiths.

Albert married Emma Jane Welsh on April 25<sup>th</sup> 1858 at the Trinity Reformed Church (United Church of Christ) in York, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>4</sup> Emma Jane Welsh was born September 30<sup>th</sup> 1840 to George Welsh and Sarah Witt in York, York County Pennsylvania. <sup>5</sup>

Albert was a tinsmith by trade, and the family always lived in North Queen Street in York Pennsylvania.

Albert inherited a 9<sup>th</sup> interest in his father's and brother, Jacob Heckert Jr.'s, estate, and 72<sup>nd</sup> interest in his mother's estate.

Albert was 65 years old when he died at 10:45 A.M. of apoplexy on October 16<sup>th</sup> 1897 at his home, 114 North Queen Street in York Pennsylvania. He was laid to rest October 20<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill cemetery in York Pennsylvania. <sup>6</sup> FAG#:156240238

- In Albert's Guardianship Petition, his son Oscar was 14 years old, and was issued a guardian; Frank G. Metzger. Albert's son, Henry C. Heckert, was the assigned attorney order to manage the interest of all heirs from Albert's parent's estate and will, and Albert's interest. <sup>7</sup>

Emma was 72 years old when she died at home on March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1913. She was laid to rest March 6<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. Her son Henry Heckert of 209 North Queen Street was the informant on her death certificate. <sup>8</sup> FAG#:156240298

In 1900 Emma indicated she had seven children and seven were still living. This was confirmed by Albert's 1897 Guardianship Petition. <sup>9</sup>

i. Frank H. Heckert was born September 12<sup>th</sup> 1858<sup>i</sup> in York, York County Pennsylvania. Frank was single, living at 50 South Pine Street in York, when at 77 years old when he died on September 22<sup>nd</sup> 1935. He was laid to rest September 28<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. Charles Heckert of 50 South Pine Street in York was the informant on Frank's death certificate.<sup>10</sup> FAG#: 156240466

ii. Henry Clay Heckert was born June 19<sup>th</sup> 1860 in York Pennsylvania. He was an Attorney, and secretary of the York County ???

Henry was 64 years old, married, living in his parent's home at 114 North Queen Street in York, when he died December 11<sup>th</sup> 1924. He was laid to rest December 13<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. His son Edgar F. Heckert, of 480 Madison Avenue in York, was the informant on Henry's death certificate.<sup>11</sup> FAG#: 100160696

iii. Catharine S. Heckert was born January 24<sup>th</sup> 1862 in York, York County Pennsylvania. She never married, and lived with her parents at 114 North Queen Street in York Pennsylvania. Catherine was 43 years old when she died January 17<sup>th</sup> 1906. She was laid to rest January 20<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery in York. Her mother Emma was the informant on Catherine's death certificate.<sup>12</sup> FAG#:156240523

iv. George W. Heckert was born January 27<sup>th</sup> 1864 in York Pennsylvania.<sup>13</sup> He married Rebecca Wehrly on March 27<sup>th</sup> 1888 at the Asbury United Methodist Church in York Pennsylvania.<sup>14</sup>

Rebecca was born November 26<sup>th</sup> 1865 to George Wehrly and Harriet Vinton in York, York County Pennsylvania. Her father was born in Pennsylvania, and her mother in Maryland.<sup>15</sup>

George and his family lived at 56 South Beaver Street in York, where at 70 years old, he died June 25<sup>th</sup> 1934. He was laid to rest June 27<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. George's son George A. Heckert, of York, was the informant on George's death certificate.<sup>16</sup> FAG#:

Rebecca was 83 years old when she died August 16<sup>th</sup> 1949. She was laid to rest August 19<sup>th</sup> with her husband at Prospect Hill Cemetery.<sup>17</sup> FAG#:100160708

v. Margie (Mary M) Heckert was born about 1869 in York, York County Pennsylvania. She lived with the family in 1870 and 1880. She married John P. Julius on March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1892 in York.<sup>18</sup>

vi. Howard Welsh Heckert was born August 24<sup>th</sup> 1871 to Albert F. Heckert and Emma Jane Welsh in York Pennsylvania.<sup>19</sup> He was 20 years old when he applied for a marriage license on December 1<sup>st</sup> 1891 in York, York County Pennsylvania. On December 3<sup>rd</sup> 1891 Howard married 15 year old Lillie Agnes Doll.<sup>20</sup>

Lillie was born December 8<sup>th</sup> 1875 to Daniel Doll and Elizabeth Heilman in York County Pennsylvania. Both of Lillie's parents were born in York County.<sup>21</sup>

The family lived at 462 Pennsylvania Avenue in York. Howard worked as a laborer for the local Hall Paper Mill. In 1930 an uncle, Noah Gross, age 68 lived with the family.

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<sup>i</sup> Frank's birth date on his death certificate is an error, when compared with his age at the time of his death and the 1860 census record.

Howard was 65 years old when he died May 18<sup>th</sup> 1937. He was laid to rest May 21<sup>st</sup> at the Greenmount Cemetery in York. Richard A. Doll, of 452 Pennsylvania Avenue in York, was the informant on Howard's death certificate. <sup>22</sup> FAG#: 88541705

Lillie was 69 years old when she died May 10<sup>th</sup> 1945 in her home, 462 Pennsylvania Avenue in York. She was laid to rest May 13<sup>th</sup> at the Greenmount Cemetery. Her daughter Catherine ? <sup>23</sup> FAG#:88541712

In 1900 Lillie indicated she had three children, and two were still living. By 1910 she indicated having five children, and four still living.

- vii. Oscar H. Heckert was born January 30<sup>th</sup> 1883 <sup>ii</sup> in York, York County Pennsylvania. He married Isabel. Oscar was a banker, and the family lived at 3215 East Market Street in Springettsbury Township York Pennsylvania.

Oscar was 75 years old when he died August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1958 while playing golf on the 9<sup>th</sup> green of the Cool Creek Gold Club. He was laid to rest August 5<sup>th</sup> at the Prospect Hill Cemetery. His wife Isabel was the informant on his death certificate. <sup>24</sup> FAG#:

Albert Leon Heckert (1895-1968)  
(I'm Looking for Answers and Documents)

Albert Leon <sup>25</sup> Heckert was born June 24<sup>th</sup> 1895 <sup>26</sup> - <sup>iii</sup> to Howard Welsh Heckert (1871 - 1937) and Elizabeth Agnes Doll (1873 - 1945) in York, York County Pennsylvania. (What is his actual birth date; June 24<sup>th</sup> 1895 or June 21<sup>st</sup> 1896? How do you know his parent's names, what is the source and where did it come from?)

- In 1900 Albert's parents lived at 34 Mulberry Street in York. Howard and Lillie were married about 1891. Howard was identified as being born August 1872, Lillie in December 1872, Pauline in May 1892, Albert in June 1896. Lillie indicated she had three children, but only two survived. (Digital Copes of the Heckert Bible)
- Mrs. Lillie A. Heckert, widow of Howard W. Heckert, died yesterday at 12:15 a. m. at her residence, 462 Pennsylvania Avenue. She was 69. Surviving are the following children: Mrs. Charles Artzberger, Dover; Albert Heckert, Baltimore; Mrs. Kathryn Ebert, at home; Mrs. Margaret Spangler, York, and Mrs. Wilson Brown, at home; 10 grandchildren and six great grandchildren. She was a life-long member of First U. B. church. Funeral arrangements are incomplete. <sup>27</sup>

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<sup>ii</sup> Oscar's headstone at the Prospect Hill Cemetery indicates his birth year is 1882.

<sup>iii</sup> Another birth date came from his FAG#:61002196; June 21<sup>st</sup> 1896

It appears Albert moved around a lot, and was married to four different women.

Albert was 21 years old when he and 23 year old Edith May Boone Heckert,<sup>iv</sup> of York Pennsylvania, announced their intent to marry in the August 4<sup>th</sup> 1913 Fredrick Post newspaper in Maryland.<sup>28</sup>  
(Marriage Application - The License announcement and Wedding announcement are the same dates; August 4<sup>th</sup> 1913. Is this accurate, and where did the articles come from?)

Albert and Edit were quietly married Saturday morning 1913<sup>v</sup> by Reverend E. L. McLean at the parsonage of the Grace Reform Church, at 28 East 3<sup>rd</sup> Street in Fredrick, Fredrick County Maryland. After the ceremony the couple went to Edith's parent's home in Woodsboro Fredrick County. Albert and Edith will make their home in York.<sup>29</sup> (The Blair County Historical Society has quite a large collection of obituaries and may be of some help.)

- Edith was born November 16<sup>th</sup> 1885 in Frederick County Maryland to Thomas William Boone (1850 - 1917) and Nancy L. Eiler Boone (1858 - 1895). (How do you know her parent's names, what is the source and where did it come from?)

When Albert signed up for the WW I draft in April 1917, he indicated he was married with two children and they lived at 518 Smith Street in York. At the time Albert was working as a laborer for a General Roofing and Manufacturing Company in York. He also had eight months service as a private in the Pennsylvania National Guard;<sup>30</sup> Company K of the 8<sup>th</sup> Pennsylvania Army National Guard Regiment.<sup>31</sup>

Sometime after Albert registered for the draft in 1917 he left Edith, and married Ester Vergie Einsig.<sup>32</sup>  
(Where did the name "Vergie" come from? Divorce or Other County Court Records – Ester and Albert Marriage Application)

- By 1920 Edith went to live near her brother and parents in the city of Polo, Located in Buffalo Township Ogle County Illinois. She indicated she was a widow, and she was living with her was her one son Thomas. Edith's other son, Murray, was living with Edith's bother, Murray Boone, in the Buffalo Township area.
- In 1930 Edith, Thomas, and Murray lived in Polo, and she indicated she was married.

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<sup>iv</sup> Edith's age in the news article is listed as 23, but she was born in 1885, her age is really 27.

<sup>v</sup> The date of marriage is listed as 1912 in Thomas Heckert's Bible and this was the date usually cited, but the news article identifies the wedding as occurring in 1913. The 1912 date may have been used since Thomas as born in 1914, just 5 months after the 1913 date.

- By 1940 Edith indicated she was a widow, and she was living with her son Thomas lived in Sterling, Whiteside County Illinois. Edith's other son was living with his father in Conewago Township, York County Pennsylvania. Conewago is about 10 miles north of York.

Also in 1920 Albert and his new wife Ester were living on Summit Street in Harrisburg Dauphin County Pennsylvania. Albert was a solicitor for the newspaper. It was during this time that their first two children were born; Betty and Marilyn. While Albert worked for the Patriot and Evening News in Harrisburg, he was responsible for collecting subscription and advertisement payments from local business, merchants and other customers.

It was during the period between July and August 1928, while Albert was collecting payments in York city, that he kept the payments for his personal use, and never turned the money over to the Patriot and Evening News Company. The following people accounts for the \$121.00 that Albert received from customers, and never turned over to the company. Albert was put on parole, and made restitution. <sup>33</sup>

- \$20.40 from Charles Foreni – July 30<sup>th</sup> 1928

- \$7.00 from Heneeth Shanabaugh – August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1928
- \$8.45 from Robert Freedi – August 6<sup>th</sup> 1928
- \$7.32 from Sylvester Nell – August 7<sup>th</sup> 1928
- \$15.35 from Marian Stauffer – August 8<sup>th</sup> 1928
- \$21.50 from Willard Saltz giver – August 8<sup>th</sup> 1928
- \$9.86 from Milton Martin – August 28<sup>th</sup> 1928

By 1930 Albert and Ester lived at 516 West Philadelphia Street in York Pennsylvania, where Albert worked as a fireman for a local hotel.

- Albert and Ester had three daughters; Betty J. Heckert born about 1921, Marilyn M. Heckert born about 1925, and Louise E. Heckert born about 1931.
- By November 5<sup>th</sup> 1940 Betty applied for a marriage license, and on November 12<sup>th</sup> she married Kenneth R. Sechrist in York Pennsylvania. <sup>34</sup>
- In 1939 Marilyn and Louise were assigned to Paul H. Stein, who was identified as the girl's guardian in John H. Einsig's will; the girl's grandfather. <sup>35</sup> However, by 1940 both girls were living in the Tressler Orphans Home <sup>vi</sup> in Loysville, Tyrone Township Perry County Pennsylvania, which is about 50 miles North of York, York County Pennsylvania.

Esther was 32 years old when she died January 18<sup>th</sup> 1932 at York Hospital. She was laid to rest January 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Mt. Rose Cemetery in York Pennsylvania. Her husband was informant on her death certificate. <sup>36</sup> FAG#:153100713

After Ester died Albert married Purdon Arbella Shorts about 1933. Purdon was born about 1914 to John and Lucy Shorts in York Pennsylvania. In 1935 Albert and Purdon lived on Gay Street in York. <sup>37</sup>

By 1940 Albert and Purdon lived in Conewago Township York County Pennsylvania. Living with him was his son Murray, from his 1<sup>st</sup> marriage with Edith, and Albert's new son with Purdon; John L. Heckert. Albert was a cutter for the Hall Paper manufacturer. (Marriage Application)

When Albert's mother, Lillie, died in 1945, Albert and his family lived in Baltimore Maryland. <sup>38</sup>

Edith Boone-Heckert died July 14<sup>th</sup> 1962 in Sterling Township in Whiteside County Illinois. She was laid to rest at the Fairmount Cemetery in the city of Polo, Ogle County Illinois. FAG#:88952301

(What Happened to Purdon?)

After Purdon, about 1950, Albert married Esther Zorick, and they 1<sup>st</sup> lived in Blandburg, Reade Township Cambria County Pennsylvania. Afterwards they moved about 50 miles south and lived at 1139 2<sup>nd</sup> Street in Windber, located in Paint Township in Somerset County Pennsylvania. <sup>39</sup>

Ester died sometime prior to Albert. (Zorick Zorak- Checkout Trafford that borders in both Allegheny and Westmorland County, near Pittsburg Pennsylvania)

Albert died August 17<sup>th</sup> 1968 in Cambria County. He was laid to rest in Plot A/365 at the Pleasant Hill United Methodist Church Cemetery in Glasgow, Read Township Cambria County Pennsylvania. FAG#:61002196 <sup>vii</sup>

- Albert L. Heckert of 1139 2nd St., Windber, formerly of Blandburg, died Saturday in Memorial Hospital, Johnstown. He was born June 24, 1896, in York, a son of Howard and Elizabeth (Doll) Heckert and married Esther Zorick, who preceded him in death. Mr. Heckert served in the National Guard during the Mexican border expedition. Friends will be received. <sup>40</sup>
