There were several Snyder families in Yoe, in fact the first name of the town was Snyderstown, but when the P.O. opened in Yoe there was already a Snyderstown in PA.

Yoe was founded on two farms, one belonging to Jacob Snyder who bought the farm in 1815 and the other belonged to Henry Taylor. In 1871 Aaron Snyder, a son-in-law to Jacob Snyder moved back to the family farm and bought 8 acres and 100 perches from part of the Taylor farm, which was then owned by Henry Taylor's son Zacharia, and set up a sawmill operation. In 1880 Moses Snyder, a son of Aaron's, bought another tract of land from the Taylor family farm and built a house and a building which housed a store and cigar factory, thus establishing the first cigar manufacturing shop not only in the borough but also the county.

In 1888 the people of Snyderstown applied for a permit for P.O., but were turned down. So Moses Snyder suggested the name of "Yohe" in honor of his mother and Aaron Snyder's first wife Catherine Yohe. So as not to offend the second wife of Aaron, Moses suggested dropping the "H" out of the name and thus spelling of "Yoe" was derived.

Area, but I believe they were from Chanceford. The Sitler's lived in Red Lion, but not sure where they came from.

> I know as far back to my Great Grandfather Moses Snyder who helped build the Salem Church in Yoe, the town is named for his mother, Catherine. My Grandfather's name was James B. and he was married twice, my father is the only child from the second marriage, but would like to know what happened to

the brothers and sisters he had from his first marriage, also am looking for any brothers and sisters for James, other than Ana Smith. As for the Gulden's they are pretty much a mystery. We have found that they hail from around Gettysberg, but my great grandfather Harry was the only one we have record on for his family. Mother, father and siblings are a mystery.

> On the Urey Side(My mother's side), I know of my great grandfather, George

A. Sr. He was married to Elsie Tome, but do not know where they came from, or if he had any other relatives. As for the Sitlers, I do not know any more than the name Russell Sitler, he was married to my Great Grandmother, Mary Jane before his passing, and I know they had two daughters, my grandmother and her sister.

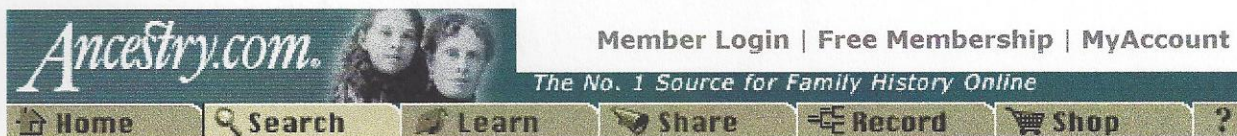

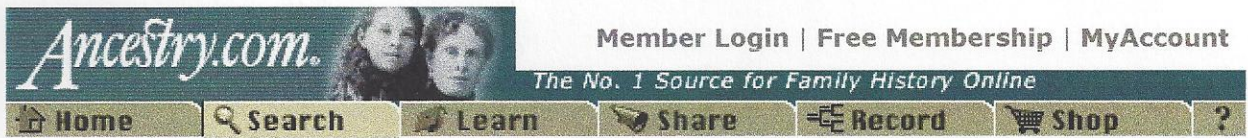
