

## Heinrich Schwartz (d. 1789)

Janelle's 5<sup>th</sup> Great Grandparents: Heinrich Schwartz and Magdalena Schaffer.

Heinrich (Henry) lived in Springfield and Shrewsbury Townships of York County, Pennsylvania.

He married Magdalena Schaffer, <sup>1</sup> and may have lived in Strasburg Township, Lancaster County, prior to the establishment of York County in 1749, where he and his wife lived in the Springfield, and Codorus Townships of York County.

Henry may have had relatives who also lived in Springfield and Shrewsbury Townships.

- Brothers:
  - Jacob Schwartz who married Dorothea who sponsored a baptism of Henry's son, George.
  - Conrad Schwartz who married Dorothea, who sponsored a baptism of Henry's daughter, Anna Magdalena.
    - Conrad and Dorothea had a child. Anna Margaretha Schwartz was baptized June 25<sup>th</sup> 1768, witnessed by Felix Kladfelder and Anna Margr Schwartz. <sup>2</sup>
  - Andrew Schwartz, whose daughter, Catherine Schwartz, was witness to Henry's Catherine.
  - Michael Schwartz who married Eva Buschung. Their children included: <sup>3</sup>
    - i. Johann Michael Schwartz was born January 25<sup>th</sup> 1758 to Michael Schwartz and Eva Buschung in Lower Windsor Township, York County, and baptized February 12<sup>th</sup> 1758 at Conejohela or Canadochly Evangelical Lutheran Church. Sponsors were George Dietz and Anna Margaretha Schmid.
    - ii. Anna Margaretha Schwartz was born August 3<sup>rd</sup> 1760 to Michael Schwartz and Eva Buschung in Lower Windsor Township, York County, and baptized at Conejohela or Canadochly Evangelical Lutheran Church. Sponsors were Michael Konig and Catherine.

- iii. Anna Elisabeth Schwartz was born January 9<sup>th</sup> 1763 to Michael Schwartz and Eva Buschung in Lower Windsor Township, York County, and baptized January 16<sup>th</sup> 1763 at Conejohela or Canadochly Evangelical Lutheran Church. Sponsors were Johann Georg Buschung, the mother's brother, and Anna Elisabeth, Jacob Dellinger's youngest single daughter, Annah.
- Unknown Relationship: Michael Schwartz who was born December 14<sup>th</sup> 1806 to Jacob and Magdalena Swartz, and baptized January 24<sup>th</sup> 1807, witnessed by Michael Geisselmann. <sup>4</sup>

In 1786 there were 14 Schwartz and Schneider men living in Shrewsbury Township, York County. All the Swartz men in 1786 were most likely related: Henry, Andrew, Conrad, another Henry, and Jacob Schwartz. <sup>5</sup>

On April 10<sup>th</sup> 1787 Henry Schwartz purchased 40 acres in York Township, York County at 10 pounds per 100 acres. The land border the lands of John Long, Jacob Correl, Michael Moser Junior, Joseph Hartung, and Henry Schwartz's other lands. <sup>6</sup>

On December 20<sup>th</sup> 1789 John Glatfelter and John Henrich presented a signed witness statement, testifying they were present when Heinrich Schwartz of Shrewsbury Township, wrote and signed his will, which was written in German. Heinrich's son, Henry Schwartz, and Theobold Schneider of Springfield Township, York County, were named executors. The will also mentioned Dewalt Schneider, Jacob Schwartz, and Abraham Schwartz.

On January 27<sup>th</sup> 1790 Magdalena Schwartz, widow of Henry Schwartz, deceased, late of Codorus Township, York County, and Peter Brillhard, and John Kleinfelter of Shrewsbury Township, entered into an agreement with Jacob Barnitz, who was paid \$150 pounds to administer the probate the inventory.

On January 25<sup>th</sup> 1801 the executors of Heinrich estate, Henry Schwartz and Theobold Schneider, finalized the estate inventory, valued at 164 pounds, 4 shillings, 8 pence.

Henry and Magdalena children included.

- i. Henry Swartz (1774-1844). He married Anna Mary Zech.
- ii. Justina Schwartz was born September 1776, and baptized September 10<sup>th</sup>, sponsored by Anna Maria Schwartz's grandmother, Catharina Schaffer. <sup>7</sup>

- iii. Elisabeth Schwartz was born February 5<sup>th</sup> 1779, and her baptism was sponsored by Elizabth Kleinfelter, daughter of George. <sup>8</sup>
- iv. George Schwartz was born May 30<sup>th</sup> 1781, and baptized June 10<sup>th</sup>, sponsored by Jacob and Doretha Schwartz. <sup>9</sup>
- v. Johann Jacob Schwartz. He married Rosina (Rosana) Zeck. <sup>10</sup> Their children included:
  - a. Justina Schwartz was born December 14<sup>th</sup> 1801, and baptized October 19<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by George and Saleme Minnich. <sup>11</sup>
  - b. Dorothea Schwartz was born December 18<sup>th</sup> 1803, and her baptism was witnessed by John and Dorothea Gladfelter. John's sister Doretha Schwartz. <sup>12</sup>
  - c. Jacob Schwartz was born January 1<sup>st</sup> 1805, and baptized March 2<sup>nd</sup>, witnessed by Jacob Baumann and wife Catherine. <sup>13</sup>
  - d. Daniel Schwartz was born April 17<sup>th</sup> 1806, and baptized May 24<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by Peter Schwartz, single. <sup>14</sup>
  - e. Rosina Schwartz was born June 11<sup>th</sup> 1807, and botanized July 18<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by Henry and Anna Maria Schwartz. <sup>15</sup>
  - f. Catherine Schwartz was born October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1808, and baptized December 18<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by John Olb and wife Catherine. <sup>16</sup>
  - g. Eva Schwartz was born January 2<sup>nd</sup> 1810, and baptized March 18<sup>th</sup> 1811, witnessed by Eva Zech, single. <sup>17</sup>
  - h. Salome Schwartz was born May 24<sup>th</sup> 1811, and baptized July 11<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by Christina Zech, single. <sup>18</sup>
- vi. Anna Margaretha (Mary) Schwartz was born March 2<sup>nd</sup> 1783, and baptized March 23<sup>rd</sup>, sponsored by Conrad and Dorothea Schwartz. <sup>19-20</sup> Mary married George K. Taylor (1777-1858). <sup>21</sup>
  - Janelle's 4<sup>th</sup> Great Grandparents: George K. Taylor and Anna Margaretha Schwartz.
- vii. Catharine Schwartz was born April 2<sup>nd</sup> 1786, and baptized April 9<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by Catherine Schwartz, daughter of Andrew Schwartz. <sup>22</sup>

## Heinrich Schwartz (1774-1844)

Heinrich (Henry) Swartz was born April 23<sup>rd</sup> 1774. <sup>23</sup>

Henry's married Anna Mary Zech, who was born April 30<sup>th</sup> 1778 to Michael and Dorothea Zech in Shrewsbury Township, York County.

- Michael Zeck married Dorothea. Michael made out his will on October 19<sup>th</sup> 1810, which was proven on August 30<sup>th</sup> 1817. The executors were: Michael's eldest son, William Zeck, and Jacob Falkinstein of Shrewsbury Township. Michael and Dorothea Zeck's children. <sup>24</sup>

Henry and his wife lived in Shrewsbury Township, York County. His will and inventory were written in German. Suggesting the will was hand written by Henry and the inventory by his wife Magdalena.

Henry was 70 years old when he died May 27<sup>th</sup> 1844. He was laid to rest at the Friedensaal Lutheran Church Cemetery, Seven Valleys, York County, Pennsylvania. FAG#: 102033673 <sup>i</sup>

Henry died without a will, in testate. Mary and the children could not reach a decision on how to divide Henry's estate up among everyone. So, on August 4<sup>th</sup> 1844 Mary Swartz, along with her children, petitioned the court to assign seven men to advise the court on how to divide 140 acres, and 57 acres, and 5 acres of land among everyone. <sup>25</sup>

Anna Mary was 74 years old when she died September 18<sup>th</sup> 1852 in Shrewsbury Township. She was laid to rest at the New Hope United Church of Christ Cemetery, Glen Rock, York County. FAG#: 44077047 <sup>ii</sup>

Henry and Mary Swartz children included. <sup>26</sup>

- viii. Henry Swartz Junior was born September 15<sup>th</sup> 1798, and his baptism was witnessed by Jacob and Catharine.
- ix. Anna (Polly) Schwartz was born December 22<sup>nd</sup> 1805, and baptized January 5<sup>th</sup> 1806, witnessed by Anna Maria, single. <sup>27</sup> Anna Maria may be Henry's sister, Anna Margaretha. Polly married John Bahn
- x. Dorothea Swartz. She married Fredrick Gladfelter.
- xi. Elizabeth Swartz was born March 13<sup>th</sup> 1795, and baptized April 26<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by John and Anna Maria Henrich. Not married in 1844. <sup>28</sup>
- xii. Maria Magdalena Schwartz was born May 5<sup>th</sup> 1800, and baptized June 29<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by Henry's mother, Magdalena Schwartz. <sup>29</sup> Maria (Mary) married George Taylor (1803-1886), <sup>30</sup> who is the son of George Taylor (1777-1858)
- xiii. Catherine Swartz was born July 30<sup>th</sup> 1807, and baptized August 16<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by Fredrick Bahn and wife Catherine. In 1844 Catherine was a widow of Mr. Beckley
- xiv. John Schwartz who was born October 26<sup>th</sup> 1808 to Henry and Anna Maria Schwartz, and baptized November 20<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by John Schwartz and wife Rosina. <sup>31</sup>

- xvii. Leah Swartz was born May 17<sup>th</sup> 1818, and baptized July 26<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by the parents. <sup>34</sup>  
Not married in 1844.
- xviii. Rachel Swartz was born November 24<sup>th</sup> 1819, and baptized July 6<sup>th</sup>, witnessed by the parents. <sup>35</sup> Rachel married Jerimiah Krebbs
