## Daniel B. Ferree (1847-1926)

Daniel B. Ferree was born April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1847 to Jacob Ferree and Katharyn Wagner in Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania.<sup>1</sup>

In 1860 he was a laborer living in Lower Windsor Township, York County, Pennsylvania. He stood 5' 1" tall and had brown hair and gray eyes. Daniel was a Civil War veteran, enlisting at 18 years old in Lancaster on February 23<sup>rd</sup> 1865. He mustered into service that same day as a private with Co. F, 195<sup>th</sup> Pennsylvania Infantry. Daniel was honorably discharged with his company on January 31<sup>st</sup> 1866. <sup>2</sup>

Daniel married Mary Ann Fry (Frey) on March 25<sup>th</sup> 1873 in York, York County, Pennsylvania. Mary Ann was born October 22<sup>nd</sup> 1852 to Joshua Frey and Julianna Kinard in York County, Pennsylvania.<sup>3</sup>

By 1880 the family lived in Springfield, York County, Pennsylvania, where Daniel worked as a cigar maker. In 1900 the Ferree family lived in Seven Valley, York Count, Pennsylvania. Daniel and his daughter Mary both worked as cigar makers.

The family were members of the St. Paul's Evangelical church at Seven Valleys. By 1910 the family lived at 219 Church Street in Springfield, York County, where Daniel and his son, Henry, worked as a laborer in a cigar factory. Charles also worked a laborer for odd jobs.

Daniel Ferree was 78 years, 6 months, and 29 days old when he died from complication of diseases, "chronic Bright's disease" leading to "uremia." at 11:12 pm on Saturday, November 25<sup>th</sup> 1925.<sup>4</sup>

Daniel was 78 years old when he died November 21<sup>st</sup> 1925. He was laid to rest at the Mount Prospect Cemetery, Seven Valleys, York County, Pennsylvania. <sup>5</sup> FAG#: 59514784 <sup>i</sup>

• When Daniel died, he left behind his widow and the following children: Mrs. Henry Behler, York; Mrs. D. H. Hamme, Seven Valleys; Mrs. Lester Bollinger, Glen Rock; Charles Ferree, Windsor; Harry and Miss Tillie Ferree, Seven Valleys. <sup>6</sup>

- v. Mary I. Ferree (1882–1978). Mary was born August 1882, and lived with the family in 1900. She married Mr. Hamme.
- vi. Lizzie I. Ferree (1885–1892)
- vii. Anna Julia (Juliann) Ferree (1888–1972). Juliann was born a twin in May 1888, and lived with the family in 1900. She married Mr. Bollinger.
- viii. Henry A. Ferree (1889-1935). He was born a twin in May 1888, and lived with the family in 1900.
  - ix. Charles Edward Ferree (1890-1968). He married Grace M. Fitzkee.
  - x. Tillie V. Ferree (1893-1979). She was born March 1893, and lived with the family in 1900.
